At the end of each article there is a short quiz that checks each child's understanding of different parts of the text. Every article is available at multiple reading levels so our teachers can assign precisely the right level to each pupil. They can also switch supporting features like British accent Read Alouds on and off for a personalised learning experience.

Your child can log into their Rockerbox News account at home online or via the Rockerbox News app. New articles are added every day so your child is encouraged to log in to read any articles they like at home. They should also look at their 'Tasks' section for activities that they have been assigned by their teacher.
