

Crossroads Student Transition Program

The Crossroads Student Transition Program is a Minot Public Schools educational program for students ages 18-21 currently on an IEP (Individual Education Plan) and who have met the credit requirements for graduation. The program is on the Minot State University Campus.

The program facilitates the transition from academic-focused learning to community-based job exploration, independent living, community access and recreation and leisure.

Emphasis is placed on fostering self-determination, self-advocacy, a rich environment of exploration and a culture of continuous discovery.
