The **Degree Qualifications Profile (DQP)** is a learning-centered framework for what college graduates should know and be able to do to earn the associate's, bachelor's and/or master's degree(s). A project of the Lumina Foundation, the profile was first published in 2011, revised in 2014, and underwent a second revision by the National Institute for Learning Outcomes Assessment (NILOA) in 2021. The DQP framework is composed of five essential categories of student expectations:

- Specialized/Industry Knowledge
- Broad and Integrative Knowledge
- Intellectual Skills
- Applied and Collaborative Learning
- Civic/Democratic and Global Learning
