



BENEFITS OF EMPLOYMENT WITH PCSD-RE2

Below is a brief description of the benefits you gain by joining our team! Further information on each of these benefits can be found in the Professional Agreement or various district policies.

Life Insurance and Long Term Disability: Teachers and SSPs who work full time are covered by the District's group life insurance and long-term disability insurance plans. All teachers and SSPs who work full time are also eligible for the District's health insurance plan. These teachers and SSPs also may participate in the District's tax-sheltered annuity program, if one is offered. Teachers and SSPs are required to participate in the Public Employees' Retirement Association to which both the teacher and the District make monthly contributions. (2026-2028 Professional Agreement)	Health Insurance (including medical, dental and vision) Effective July 1, 2023, the District will contribute a maximum of \$8874.00 per year for the insurance package and any premium increases above this amount shall be split equally between the District and each eligible teacher who enrolls for coverage under the District's group health, dental, vision, and life insurance plans. A teacher's or SSP's spouse or dependents may be included in the teacher's health care coverage at an additional cost to the teacher or SSP. (2026-2027 CEBT Benefits) (2025-2026 Benefits Information)
Public Employees' Retirement Association (PERA): Both the teacher and the District make monthly contributions.	General Leave Days: Unlike other districts we classify our days at "general leave" so they may be used at the discretion of the employee. Each full time employee will receive 11 days per year at the start of their contract. (2026-2028 Professional Agreement)
Year for Year on the Salary Schedule Unlike most other districts, we honor all years of teaching experience when placing new-hires on our salary schedule. (2026-2028 Professional Agreement)	4-Day School Week: A 4-day school week provides ample time for exploring our mountains. Teachers work 146 days which includes professional development and teacher work days.
Bereavement Days: The district will allow up to 4 days per death. (2026-2028 Professional Agreement)
