Week 1

CREATION

Globe- hands cupped in front of face make giant ball to waist.

FALL IN THE GARDEN

Sign for FALL- both hands with palms down fall from shoulder height to waist.

CAIN AND ABEL

ASL LETTER C (cupped R hand in C shape) then LETTER A (R hand fist faces up)

THE FLOOD

Palms facing down at waist go straight up like water rising.

THE TOWER OF BABEL

TOWER sign- cupped hands face each other and go up like shaping a wide pillar)

UNIFICATION OF UPPER AND LOWER EGYPT, 3000 BC

UNITY sign- both hands make 'ok' with thumb and index and link them, facing up and down to signify upper and lower, then 3000 sign- 3 fingers of R hand up, then they turn down to tap L palm facing up.

THE OLD KINGDOM IN EGYPT

Bend over with L hand on back as if sore, R thumb pointing over shoulder

INDUS VALLEY CIVILIZATION

VALLEY sign- R hand flat, palm down, goes straight to L, down in a V, then back up.

Week 2

ANCIENT CRETE AND MINOAN CIVILIZATION

BULL sign- thumbs on temples, pinkies out, other fingers down, like horns- wiggle

SARGON THE GREAT UNITES SUMER AND AKKAD

UNITY sign- linked 'ok' signs (just not up and down like Upper/Lower Egypt)

GOD'S COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM, 2082 BC

COVENANT sign- R index up over mouth like 'shhh', then R fist slams L palm face up.

HAGAR AND ISHMAEL

REJECTED sign-2 'thumbs up' meet and then are torn apart in opposite directions

SODOM AND GOMORRAH

Act like you are running forward then look behind you and freeze, like Lot's wife who became a pillar of salt.

BIRTH AND SACRIFICE OF ISAAC

Cradle baby in arms, then SACRIFICE sign- both arms raised and eyes lifted upward.

THE MIDDLE KINGDOM IN EGYPT

MIDDLE sign- R hand moves down torso- hand like ASL LETTER E for Egypt

JOSEPH IS A SLAVE

Palms up, wrists touching, as if chained together.

Week 3

FAMINE IN EGYPT

Rub hungry belly.

TWELVE TRIBES OF ISRAEL, 1860 BC

Hold up 10 fingers, then 2 more to equal 12.

BABYLON AND THE CODE OF HAMMURABI

LAW sign- ASL LETTER L slides down L palm facing out.

SHANG DYNASTY IN CHINA

SILK sign- thumbs and index fingers rub and tug imaginary smooth fabric

HYKSOS INVADE EGYPT

Shoot an arrow.

THE HITTITE EMPIRE

IRON sign- Pinkies rub together like making a fire with flint.

EARLY NEW KINGDOM IN EGYPT

Stretch both arms out like waking early.

OLMECS AND ZAPOTECS IN SOUTH AMERICA

MEXICO sign-index and 3rd finger slide along upper lip 2x like a moustache.

Week 4

MOSES, THE PLAGUES IN EGYPT

R hand fist pounds down like holding a staff, then PEST sign- L wiggling index flies down to touch R index pointing straight up.

THE EXODUS, 10 COMMANDMENTS

Hold up 10 fingers

MYCENAEAN CIVILIZATION

GREECE sign- thumb and index finger slide down nose

AMENHOTEP IV, 1350 BC

4 fingers face down, then up for 4th

TUTANKHAMEN REIGNS IN EGYPT

Cross arms on chest and close eyes (think mummy- Tut died young)

LATER NEW KINGDOM IN EGYPT

LATER sign- R hand makes letter L sign and point it forward, like 'Later dude!'

TROJAN WAR

HORSE sign- thumbs on temples, 2nd and 3rd fingers up and wiggle like ears

THE PHOENICIANS AND THE ALPHABET

Letter A, B, C signs

Week 5

DAVIDIC KINGDOM

Left hand flat in front of chest, palm facing body, R hand stumming harp motion

SOLOMON'S REIGN

Wisdom-point to forehead

ISRAEL DIVIDES INTO 2 NATIONS

Chop R hand straight out from chest for dividing into North and South

HOMER AND GREEK MYTHOLOGY

POEM sign- L arm up, palm flat, like a piece of paper, R 2nd and 3rd fingers up, thumb between, sweeping up and down the 'paper' like writing or reading a poem.

THE OLYMPICS

Run in place.

THE FOUNDING OF ROME 753 BC

TO FOUND Sign- R thumb up on clenched hand, like digging out a foundation, then plant fist on flat L hand facing down with the thumb up like a chimney on a house!

DEMOCRACY BEGINS IN GREECE

VOTE Sign- L hand like a cup, R thumb and index finger stuff 'ballots' in the cup.

GOD'S PROPHETS WARN HIS PEOPLE

Shake head and wag finger in warning.

Week 6

CONFUCIUS

"Quotation Marks" with both sets of index and 3rd fingers wiggled twice.

"Choose a job you love and you will never have to work a day in your life."

"Our greatest glory is not in falling, but in rising every time we fall."

"It does not matter how slowly you go as long as you do not stop."

ISRAEL AND JUDAH FALL TO ASSYRIA

DEFEAT Sign- R arm bent in front w/ fist, L fisted arm falls onto R arm like tree falling.

NEBUCHADNEZZAR OF BABYLON, JEWS IN EXILE

EXIT Sign-R palm up, L index strikes match and keeps pointing away

THE PERSIAN EMPIRE

COIN Sign- R palm face up, L index traces a circle on it like a coin

(They introduced gold and silver as money and first standardized coin weights)

END OF THE GREEK DARK AGES, CLASSICAL GREECE BEGINS

L hand over eyes, then lifted (I've seen the light!), then become a Greek statue- L hand on hip, R arm held up w/ upturned palm holding an invisible vase!

ROMAN REPUBLIC FOUNDED

REPUBLIC Sign- Cross 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} R fingers and wag them quickly 2x

GRECO-PERSIAN WARS 500 BC

GREECE Sign and Persian COIN Sign

PERICLES AND THE PELOPONNESIAN WAR

Fists punching each other- Civil War between Athens and Sparta.

Week 7

GREEK PHILOSOPHERS, SOCRATES, PLATO AND ARISTOTLE

Fist under chin for 'thinkers'

NEHEMIAH AND THE RETURN OF THE JEWS

Beckon with hands to the L to say, 'Come Back!'

ALEXANDER THE GREAT CONQUEROR 334 BC

Sign for letter A, then GREAT Sign- both palms out, then lifted high

THE HAN DYNASTY AND THE GREAT WALL OF CHINA

Wall- Make L's facing each other then slowly move them apart in a long wall!

THE RISE OF ROME

Palms up, then raise both slowly

REIGN OF JULIUS CAESAR

Crown yourself with a wreath of laurel behind head with cupped hands

EGYPT FALLS TO THE ROMAN EMPIRE

DEFEAT Sign, then ROME-2nd and 3rd fingers over nose (like Roman helmet)

REIGN OF CAESAR AUGUSTUS

Sign for letter C and A

Week 8

JESUS CHRIST IS BORN

Cradle a baby

MINISTRY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST

Baptize Sign- both thumbs point one way, then the other (for dunking!)

MINISTRY OF CHRIST

CHRISTIAN Sign- Letter C from R shoulder down to opposite hip.

CRUCIFIXION, RESURRECTION AND ASCENSION OF CHRIST

CRUCIFY- Middle fingers point to opposite palms, RISE- Raise hands, palms up,

Then ASCEND- point and look up

NERO FIDDLES, ROME BURNS, CHRISTIANS DIE

Play violin, BURN- fingers up like juggling balls up and down, DIE- L palm down, R palm up, then both turn over.

ROMANS DESTROY JERUSALEM IN 70 AD

L palm down, R reaches to grab L, then both form fists and move back

MOUNT VESUVIUS ERUPTS, POMPEII BURIED

Hands erupt upward, then hands protect head, palms up, as you look upward at the falling lava.

DIOCLETIAN DIVIDES THE ROMAN EMPIRE

Chop downward with R hand, ROME Sign

Week 9

CONSTANTINE AND THE EDICT OF MILAN

Make a big cross in the sky with both arms (he saw a vision of a cross before he went into battle)

FIRST COUNCIL OF NICEA, 325 AD

FIRST Sign, L index finger points to upraised R thumb

SAINT AUGUSTINE OF HIPPO

TRINITY Sign- R palm facing chest, L index finger up behind palm, then comes under and around R hand and becomes three fingers.

SAINT JEROME COMPLETES THE VULGATE

Open a Bible in the air and bring it downward (putting the Bible in the people's hands)

BARBARIANS INVADE, ROME SACKED

INVADE Sign- L flat palm over R flat palm facing down, then both hands down like claws

ST PATRICK BRINGS CHRISTIANITY TO IRELAND

IRELAND Sign- R hand down, L index and third finger bent down in the air over R hand. Move to L, then settle on R hand.

THE COUNCIL OF CHALCEDON

Truly God-point heavenward

Truly man- palms facing each other (spread apart), move downward at the same time (sign for PERSON)

ATTILA THE HUN DEFEATED

Flex both biceps, then drop both and frown ©

Week 10

MAYAN CIVILIZATION

MEXICO Sign & L hand splayed above head for feathers in your headdress

END OF THE WESTERN ROMAN EMPIRE

END Sign- R hand out, palm facing chest, L hand chop end of R fingers ROME Sign

THE BYZANTINE EMPIRE & JUSTINIAN THE GREAT

Sign for letter J, then GREAT Sign

ST BENEDICT AND MONASTICISM, 540

Put your hood over your head, monk.

MOHAMMED AND ISLAM

ISLAM Sign- Both hands flat, palms up, go up and down twice.

THE CAROLINGIANS- CHARLES MARTEL, PEPIN THE SHORT & CHARLEMAGNE

Sign for letter C and GREAT Sign.

VIKING INVASION IN LONG SHIPS

First 3 fingers of L hand on cupped R hand. Pull toward body, then forward on waves 3 times.

ALFRED THE GREAT

ENGLAND Sign- R hand flat, palm down. L hand reaches over, grasps R hand in front, and jerks up slightly once.

Week 11

OTTO THE FIRST AND THE HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE

Neither holy nor Roman- Sign for Germany- nat'l bird is an eagle- fingers splayed and crossed at wrists, flying as wings

LIEF ERIKSON SAILS TO NORTH AMERICA

Sign for America- palms facing inward, fingers of both hands intertwine like the states linked, then go around in a circle

THE CHURCH SPLITS IN 1054

Sign for Church- R hand makes a C on top of flat L hand w/ palm facing down, move up and down 2x, then split hands apart for the church breaking apart.

THE FEUDAL SYSTEM

Take money off R palm several times to pay the land lord!

WILLIAM THE CONQUEROR AND THE BATTLE OF HASTINGS IN 1066

Sign for Conquer- R arm in front of chest, L arm sits on R hand at elbow and comes down in a fist

CATHEDRALS IN EUROPE

Bring arms up to a point for a big steeple

THE CRUSADES AND THE MIDDLE AGES

Sign for Israel- open index and 3rd finger in a v and stroke chin like a beard

ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI

Devoted to sick and poor ,talked to and cared for animals, founded Franciscan Friars, Sign for Bird- Look at R thumb and index beak cheeping up and down, talking to you

Week 12

GENGHIS KHAN AND THE MONGOLS

Means Emperor of all Men, warlike, nomad from Mongolia- at 13 took over tribe when father was poisoned, ruthless, fast, well disciplined army,terrifying b/c they massacred all who did not immed. Surrender. Sign for Bully- R pointer up, L thumb and pinky out, punch R finger 2x

THE MAGNA CARTA IN 1215

A disliked King John of England is kidnapped by his nobles and forced to sign that he will obey the law and not add more taxes w/o the nobles approval, Sign for Law- R makes Letter L down L palm

ST. THOMAS AQUINAS

Called a dumb ox in school- later a brilliant theologian- sign for Cow w/ one horn on R temple

MARCO POLO

Plug nose and bend down like going under water in the game- He was a famous explorer of the East who wrote all about China to a Europe who knew nothing of the East

THE HUNDRED YEARS WAR, THE BLACK DEATH, AND JOAN OF ARC

Index finger for #1, then Sign for Letter C for Roman numeral for 100, then Sign for 'Vision' - R index to forehead then bring 2 closed hands together near eyes (like holding a rod) and splay both hands up and out

JOHN WYCLIFFE AND JOHN HUSS

Sign for Fire- both hands up and down w/ fingers wiggling like flames, for martyrs of the faith

PRINCE HENRY THE NAVIGATOR

Peer through your telescope and adjust it

FALL OF CONSTANTINOPLE TO OTTOMAN TURKS

Sign for Muslim- 2 palms up, then down 2x

Week 13

GUTENBURG PRINTS THE BIBLE, 1455

Open a book to the R, then keep opening and closing across, to show mass production

THE RENAISSANCE

Rebirth- R hand out like handshake, L makes belly then hits R palm

FERDINAND, ISABELLA, AND THE SPANISH INQUISITION

Sign for Spain- both index fingers hooked at shoulders, then come together and clasp like a shawl Sign for Interrogate- 2 hooked index fingers take turns clawing forward, angry face

THE EUROPEAN EXPLORERS, DIAS, COLUMBUS, AND AMERIGO VESPUCCI, De GAMA, De LEON AND CABOT

Sign for explore- 2nd and 3rd fingers sitting on L palm hop to the left 6x, for each explorer

COPERNICUS, THE SUN IS THE CENTER

Sun- thumb and index flourish around in a circle, then hand splays toward face as rays

MARTIN LUTHER BEGINS THE REFORMATION IN 1517

Nail the paper to the Wittenburg church door

MAGELLAN SAILS AROUND THE WORLD

Sign for ship goes around in a circle to circumnavigate the globe

Week 14

THE SPANISH CONQUISTADORS: CORTEZ AND PIZARRO

Sign for Spain again- hooked index fingers at shoulders meet and clasp at waist like a shawl

IVAN THE TERRIBLE EXPANDS RUSSIA

Sign for Russia- both hands make c's and hit sides of waist 2x like a sash

HENRY THE VIII AND THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND

Sign for 8th- thumb and middle finger touch facing down, then turn up

Sign for Church- C on L hand, Sign for England- R hand grabs L hand w/ palm facing down

CARTIER SAILS UP THE ST. LAWRENCE

Sign for Ship goes straight up

JOHN CALVIN AND THE INSTITUTES OF THE CHRISTIAN RELIGION

Sign for Christian- C from R shoulder to opposite waist

THE COUNCIL OF TRENT AND THE COUNTER REFORMATION

Catholic sign of the cross- forehead to chin and across eyes

QUEEN ELIZABETH I, 1558

Hands splayed out from neck for her big stiff collars

WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE, THE BARD OF AVON

Be Romeo- get down on one knee and look up with arms raised to Juliet's balcony

Week 15

RALEIGH SETTLES ROANOKE

Sign for Founding, as we did for Rome- R thumb scoops up earth, then is planted on L hand

JAMESTOWN IN VIRGINIA

Sign for letters V and A

CHAMPLAIN FOUNDS QUEBEC

Sign for Canada- R thumb up on heart, tap 2x

GALILEO AND THE SCIENTIFIC REVOLUTION

Sign for Science- thumbs face each other and go over and under each other 2x like an invention

1620 THE MAYFLOWER LANDS AT PLYMOUTH

Sign for ship, then turn over L hand in a fist as a Rock for the sails to land on

THE PURITANS OF MASSACHUSETTS BAY COLONY

Hands together in prayer

THE ENGLISH CIVIL WAR AND OLIVER CROMWELL

Sign for England, R hand holds onto L, then fists fighting each other

WILLIAM PENN, FOUNDER OF PENNSYLVANIA

Sign for Pen-scribbling w/R thumb and index pinched together, and Sign letters P and A

Week 16

SALEM WITCH TRIALS, 1692

Sign for Witch- hook R index over nose

SLAVERY AND THE TRIANGLE OF TRADE

Sign for slaves- wrists together, then Sign for triangle-2 index meet at top then draw a triangle together

PETER THE GREAT, CZAR OF RUSSIA

Sign for P, then Sign for Great- palms down then lift up, then sign for Russia w/ sash at waist

THE ENLIGHTENMENT

Point to forehead then up in air for a great idea

13 COLONIES FORMED

Sign for 13- three fingers up, then bend down once

THE FIRST GREAT AWAKENING

Sign for Awake- hands in C's close to eyes, which are shut, then splay out as eyes bulge open

COLONIAL TRADING WITH ENGLAND

Sign for trade- Cup both hands up, R in front, then roll it back behind L hand for making a trade

THE FRENCH AND INDIAN WARS

Sign for France- OK sign on forehead, then turn it outward away from head,

Sign for Native American- R thumb and index pinched and jump from mouth to temple like putting on war paint

Week 17

END OF THE SEVEN YEARS WAR

Sign for End- chop off end of R fingers w/ L hand, then hold up 7 fingers

BRITISH TROOPS SENT TO NORTH AMERICA, 1763

Sign for England, then march like a soldier holding a bayonet in front of you

CAPTAIN COOK EXPLORES OCEANIA AND ANTARCTICA

Sign for Explore- R index and 3rd hop on L hand, then hug yourself and shiver for cold, and point down for South

NO TAXATION WITHOUT REPRESENTATION

Shake head no, then sign for Tax- L palm facing sideways, R index hook slashes down L palm

THE FIRST CONTINENTAL CONGRESS SEEKS PEACE WITH BRITAIN

Sign for Congress- Make a C from L to R shoulder

THE SHOT HEARD ROUND THE WORLD

Cup L ear, then shoot w/R hand as a gun

AMERICA DECLARES HER INDEPENDENCE

Sign for America, then Independence- cross fists at wrists, then both pinkies come out as arms uncross upward

WASHINGTON COMMANDS THE CONTINENTAL ARMY

Index over mouth for command, then points forward (I say, you do) then salute

Week 18

WINTER AT VALLEY FORGE

Hug self like shivering with cold, then sign for Valley

BRITISH SURRENDER AT YORKTOWN AND THE TREATY OF PARIS

Wave your white flag of surrender

THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

L hand up like swearing in, palms out, R makes C on L palm, then jumps down to L elbow

MOZART AND BEETHOVEN

Play piano keys

THE FRENCH REVOLUTION BEGINS 1789

Sign for France, then guillotine- flat hands behind and in front of neck chop, with head down

WASHINGTON, AMERICA'S FIRST PRESIDENT

Sign for President-thumbs on flat hands at eyes, then move out and up and close in fists

THE LOUISIANA PURCHASE

The US bought territory from Napoleon for \$15 million that doubled the size of the nation- a real steal! Sign for Purchase- L palm up, R on top and moves forward to pay

NAPOLEON CROWNS HIMSELF EMPEROR

Pretend to pick up a crown and place it on your head

Week 19

THE LEWIS AND CLARK EXPEDITION

Sign for letter L and C, then Sign for EXPLORE

THE SECOND GREAT AWAKENING

2 fingers up for 2nd, then Sign for AWAKE 2x

WILBERFORCE, A FORCE AGAINST SLAVERY

Sign for SLAVE, then break apart for freedom

THE WAR OF 1812

America vs. the British Empire and Canada- Sign for America, England, and (or just) CANADA

NAPOLEON'S LAST BATTLE AT WATERLOO

Punch L fist into R palm 'wall'

HENRY CLAY AND THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE

Sign for COMPROMISE -R index to forehead, like an idea, then R and L index move forward and meet **THE MONROE DOCTRINE**

Declaration by Pres. James Monroe saying Europe could not colonize America or it would be considered an act of aggression. Sign for America, shake head NO, then sign for Europe

TRAVELING THE ERIE CANAL

Pole a boat in the canal with 2 hands

Week 20

THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION

Sign for INDUSTRY-R thumb holds 3 fingers down, pinky out, goes over L palm down w/ elbow bent, then fingers all clasp inward and go up and down like a handshake- looks like an assembly line

THE COTTON GIN IN THE SOUTH

Pick cotton w/ pinched thumb and index

SLAVERY IN THE SOUTH

Slave hands go downward

THE CHEROKEE TRAIL OF TEARS TO OKLAHOMA

Index finger makes tear down cheek, then OK sign

REMEMBERING THE ALAMO AND WAR WITH MEXICO, 1836

Sign for TEXAS- crooked R finger starts at temple and goes out, then down, turning into Sign for Remember, then Sign for MEXICO

SETTLING THE WEST

Sign for WEST- hold up 3 middle fingers, palm out, on L hand in front of shoulder, then move out fast

FORTY- NINERS AND THE CALIFORNIA GOLD RUSH

Sift the dirt in a panning motion, then bite on a chunk of metal to see if it's gold!

OPENING THE OREGON TERRITORY

Sign for OPEN- palms face forward together, then both go out and up

Week 21

LINCOLN, AMERICA'S 16th PRESIDENT

Touch beard, then Sign for PRESIDENT

THE WAR BETWEEN THE STATES

Sign for AMERICA, then break it apart

THE BATTLE OF GETTYSBURG, 1863

Sign for Letters P and A

13th AMENDMENT ABOLISHES SLAVERY

Hold up 3 fingers, then 10, for 13, then break slavery chains

COMPLETION OF THE TRANSCONTINENTAL RAILROAD

Arms back and forth like train, then reach up to pull rope for horn

RECONSTRUCTING THE SOUTH

Sign for RECONSTRUCT-R and L hands touch with fingers all down, then all come up like a roof, then Sign for SOUTH- fist from neck height to waist

BLACK LEADERSHIP EMERGES IN THE SOUTH

Sign for LEAD- R hand grasps L hand, both w/ thumbs up, and leads along to R, then Sign for Person- 2 palms facing each other move downward

QUEEN VICTORIA, EMPRESS OF INDIA

Sign for Victoria- V that wiggles back and forth down fast, Sign for INDIA- index finger points to forehead like putting on a sticker

THE GILDED AGE IN AMERICA

Carnegie threw rich, lavish parties (one for a dog wearing a 15,000 diamond collar), corrupt gov't, While many Americans worked in sweatshops in poverty

THE BOXER REBELLION IN CHINA

Society of harmonious fists- killed many missionaries and Chinese Christians, took an intern. Force to crush rebellion. Make boxing gloves, then Sign for CHRISTIANITY

THE PLAINS WAR, THE BATTLE OF LITTLE BIGHORN, AND COWBOYS IN THE WEST

Sign for NATIVE AMERICANS, Sign for Cow horn, then sling guns in wide circles like gunslingers

VAN GOGH PAINTS

L palm face R, R index and 3rd finger brush back and forth 3x

THE SPANISH-AMERICAN WAR

Sign for Spain then America

IMMIGRATION TO AMERICA

Make a Statue of Liberty- L hand splayed behind head, R held high holding torch

WRIGHT BROTHERS AND OTHER INVENTORS

Airplane arms

WORLD WAR I, 1914-18

Sign for WAR- Letter W with both hands facing each other fighting back and forth

Week 23

THE BOLSHEVIK REVOLUTION IN RUSSIA

Socialists, Lenin-People were poor, Sign for RUSSIA – make sash on waist

THE ROARING TWENTIES

Flapper hands and shoulders

THE GREAT DEPRESSION

Sign for DEPRESSED- splayed hands over chest, both go down with concerned face

THE HOLOCAUST

Sign for STAR- index fingers point upward alternately, then Sign for ISRAEL- stroke beard

WORLD WAR II, AXIS AND ALLIES

Sign for WAR, then hold up index fingers one at a time for 2 opposing sides

THE UNITED NATIONS

After WWII to stop wars and allow for dialogue, internat. Law tried to make world peace, now 193 countries. Sign for UNITED- clasp OK signs like chains

CHAIRMAN MAO AND COMMUNIST CHINA, 1949

Sign for COMMUNIST- C for Crescent w/L hand, R index touches it in center, then R fist in air

THE COLD WAR, KOREA, AND VIET NAM

2 hands in fists shivering with cold, then V for Viet Nam, then turn upside down and shake head NO

Week 24

Hold up sign and march

THE CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS

Russia and Cuba vs. US- Cuba built missiles to deter US from invading. US made them take missiles back to USSR and promised to dismantle missiles in Turkey/ Italy. Sign for MISSILE- both arms up in point- bend down and jump up

THE SPACE RACE

USSR vs. US- Sign for ROCKET- index and 3rd finger cross as letter R and take off R palm

THE ASSASSINATION OF JFK, 1963

Sign for DIE- One palm faces up, the other down, then they switch

Desert Storm- UN forces led by US against Iraq invading Kuwait- Sign for sweaty in desert- wipe hand across brow

WORLD TRADE CENTER ATTACKED AND THE WAR ON TERROR

Sign for NEW YORK- L palm up, R thumb and pinkyout and brush back and forth over palm, then hand on heart for Pledge Allegiance,=

AND GOD IS SOVEREIGN OVER ALL!

Point heavenward, then sign for WORLD/ Creation from Week 1
