### Principal's Report / School Updates

- Snack Program: Launched; kitchen construction nearly complete (dishwasher & hot water pending)
  - Recent Events: Assembly, Remembrance Day, progress reports, parent–teacher conferences completed

### School Travel Planning / Safety

- Audit completed; coordinator requesting:
    - 3 free bike racks
    - Updated street signage for Ingleton Blvd
  - Community walkabout planned for March; project funding advocacy underway (work projected for 2027)
  - Crossing/Pick-up Safety:
    - Short-term fix: staff to place pylon near crossing guard
  - TTC Pilot Program:
    - Student fares prepaid & reimbursed (cheaper than charter buses); adult chaperones still pay full fare

### Facilities & Maintenance

- Playground & kindergarten area revamp planned; mulch & landscaping discussed
- Gym lighting & floor replacement under review

- Stage curtains:
    - Medium quality: ~\$7,600
    - High quality: ~\$9,989 (installation separate; may be covered if safety/fire-retardant standards fail)
  - Stage lighting/audio upgrades discussed; new Bluetooth speaker/mic system purchased

#### Finance / Treasurer's Report

- Transition to new treasurer ongoing
  - Approximate council funds discussed; previous contribution: ~\$4,000 toward technology
  - Fundraising Priorities: playground equipment (~\$3,000), stage curtains, technology
-

#### Policies, Governance & Yearbook

- School Council Bylaws: template available; target completion by January meeting
  - School Statement of Needs: review in January
  - Yearbook: possible school-wide edition if teacher lead & media consents managed; parent interest poll planned
- 

#### STEM / Coding

- Current resources: LEGO Mindstorms, Dash & Dot, micro:bits
  - Coding integrated into curriculum; Hour of Code in December
  - After-school programs (robotics, glee) run by third parties; fees apply; revenue does not go to school/council
- 

#### Field Trips / Costs

- Concern about trip clustering late in year; staff asked to stagger trips
  - Typical intermediate overnight trip (e.g., Ottawa): ~\$675 per student
  - Subsidies: council fundraising + school support (~\$200 per eligible student)
-

- Discussion on formal executive roles vs. open leadership groups; staff to consider clearer expectations for student initiatives

    - Follow up on stage curtain safety, gym lighting, playground timeline & quotes
    - Post yearbook interest poll; gather cost data
    - Coordinate pylon placement at crossing area
  - Council:
    - Draft School Council bylaws; review by January
    - Continue fundraising discussion; shortlist ideas (chocolates, cookie dough, poinsettias, Santa breakfast)
    - Explore parent volunteer model for winter concert if staff cannot lead
