Principal Report:

- Student behavior is challenging right now. K-3 a lot of hands on (pushing / hitting).
 Grades 5 & 6: continued struggles with online platforms and cyber bullying. Spruce is continuing to work on reminders of behavior expectations and calming techniques (like, how are they feeling, emotional dysregulation and how to reset). Build strategies.
 Restorative practices around what harm did you do.
- Lower grass field is open! Morning walk and talk (when it's sunny). Class numbers that they use for fire drills. Walk route inside the fence line, safe and secure the entire time.
- Smarter Balance Assessment (SBA) 5th grade. 3, 4, 5, 6th May 23, 24, 25. Info in Spruce News. Results give us one moment in time one picture on one day. District will not pay for student snacks that are usually provided during the testing.
- 6th grade camp is done! Day trip, not overnight.
- Everything is on track for end of the year 2 new dual language teachers lined up for next year's Spanish immersion program. Announcing retirement for a couple of paras.
 550 / 579. Under projecting us, likely to start the new year around 600. Lots of refugees from the Ukraine coming in.
- Budget difficulties are real talking about cutting. A lot of big feels. Spruce will be okay, we did not lose staff. Our class sizes will continue to be normal (31 / 32), other buildings lost more. Emily noted there is a video from the superintendent that talks about the budget Action: Share this video on our FB, communicate how the budget is impacting Spruce

Treasurer Report:

- Bingo Night results: A total profit of \$2929.59. A huge success for our first fundraising effort. Action: Promote this success on FB and include a "if you missed Bingo night, here's a QR code to donate to our PTO"
- Fred Meyer Community Rewards sent us a \$90 check Action: Promote how to do this again on FB.
- Verdant Health Grant Mental Health May 1 June 16th. Training, Civil Unrest, Social Justice. Action: Aimee and Beth to see if we can meet this first deadline, if not there is another round of funding later.
- Spruce PTO agreed to cover student snacks for SBA Action: Beth to purchase snacks as directed by a list from Emily

- Embassy suites is open to donating a one night stay as a give-a-way. Much discussion of how to leverage this. Do <this> and enter to win this. Open house fill your passport was one idea. Open house is June 9th evening event. Final Decision: PTO table at the open house: fill out this survey (target engagement for PTO mailing list and Facebook group, and opinion survey) and enter to win 1-night at Embassy Suites. Action: Aimee to create a basic survey in SurveyMonkey.
- Field Trip Fundraising We don't need to do more fundraising right now. Let's use the
 Dragon Dash event for 2023-24 school year (typically in September) for this purpose and
 make sure funds are equally spread across classrooms, not just those who are up for
 field trips.
- Edmonds Foundation Beth notes teachers can apply for these funds for field trips.
 Others noted these applications are not short and easy and often come with strings attached (like requirements to attend a dinner after school hours during their personal time). We should target teacher engagement / Spruce PTO as an objective for next school year. Action: Add this resource to our Spruce PTO website
