## **Making if statements (in Diplomacy)**

#### 1st Conditional

The 1st conditional is used for real and possible situations in the future. It describes something that is likely to happen if a certain condition is met.

#### Structure:

• [If + present simple,] [will + base verb]

## **Example Sentences:**

- 1. If Italy attacks Trieste, they will capture the city.
- 2. Turkey will gain control of Bulgaria, if they move their army there.
- 3. If Russia supports an attack on Turkey from Sevastopol, they will weaken Turkey's defenses.

#### 2nd Conditional

The 2nd conditional is used for hypothetical or unlikely situations. It describes what would happen if a certain condition, which is not real or unlikely, were true.

#### Structure:


• [If + past simple,] [would + base verb]

## **Example Sentences:**

- 1. If Germany **controlled** Sweden, they **would have** a stronger northern front.
- 2. Austria would be in a better position if they had more alliances.
- 3. If England had more armies in France, they would be able to defend better.

By using the 1st and 2nd conditionals, you can discuss potential and hypothetical scenarios on the gameboard and better plan your strategies.
