James 3:1-2

- Q) What in your opinion James means by "bridling your whole body"? Why do you think he says that?

James 3:3-6

- Q) What is your understanding of verses 4-5?
- Q) How is the tongue like the fire in the forest?
- Q) According to verse 6, if the tongue is set to defile the whole body, is it advisable to be silent more often?

James 3:7-12

- Q) What does James mean in verse 8 when he says, "no man can tame the tongue"?
- Q) Can you relate to verse 9? What can we learn from verse 9?
- Q) During struggling times, in what ways can you tune your mind to see people as the image of God?
- Q) How can you explain verses 11-12?
- Q) According to you, what is the significance of a tongue? Why did God give us a tongue?
- Q) What do you think is the solution to an untamable tongue?
