

Art Research Project Art History, Grades 6-12

Assignment Objectives

- Students will research a famous artist or art movement they are learning about in class.
- Students will work with a Live Help tutor to research and develop their writing piece, and then submit their written work to the Review Center for feedback.

Teacher Instructions

- Assign students an artist or artistic movement they will research and then develop a
 presentation of their findings. The presentation could include an essay, slideshow,
 Google Slides presentation, or any presentation method in PDF form!
- This activity is designed to encourage students to research the artist or artistic movement and explore their influences on art.
- Students can use the included graphic organizer as aid in research, to get clarification and feedback, and summarize their thoughts with the help of a Paper Tutor
- After completing the graphic organizer with the Live Help tutor, students will then present their research in the format expressed by the teacher.

Ideas for Use

- Assign in class or as a homework assignment.
- Assign to accompany current topics of class instruction.
- For lesson extension, encourage students to create their own piece of art reflective of the artist's style or artistic movement.
- This can be completed individually, in pairs, or in a group. If implemented in a group setting, one student should be responsible for starting a session with the Live Help tutor to relay information to other group members.
