FAQ

What are the travel arrangements from Zurich Airport?

From Zurich, take the train to Lucerne and then a bus or taxi to the Gondola station. There, they'll board the gondolas and head up the mountain. The train from Zurich to Lucerne takes about an hour, and the gondola takes about 30–45 minutes.

What are the times of the Gondola ride schedules to access the hotel?

The Gondola ride schedule is from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. In winter, it could be stormy, and the gondola may not operate. Last year, it was closed for 5 days.

Is there medical support on site?

As we are in a mountain area, there is no hospital on site; the closest is in Lucerne, accessible by gondola. However, the Pilatus has a first-aid kit, and most staff members have medical training.

What is the cost for single or double occupancy?

- Single occupancy: 1400 for the week, all inclusive.
- Double occupancy with only one participant in the seminar: 2100 for the week, all inclusive.

- Double occupancy with both participants in the seminar: 2640 for the week, all inclusive.

What activities or amenities are available on the mountain in January?

We have an art installation called "Breathe with Pilatus" during your stay, which is free. We also offer:

- Wine degustation with a famous sommelier from Lucerne.
- Options for a small hike with our nature guides (if possible).
- A fun sledding route down from Pilatus if it's snowing (depending on the weather).
- Astronomy evenings with our physicist, featuring a tour, star watching, and a small presentation.

Note that we do not have ski slopes or winter sports destinations, so we will suggest activities that are less affected by the weather.

Can we get to the hotel on the weekend before the event?

Unfortunately, you can only arrive on Monday morning as the hotel is fully booked for the weekend before.

Are there any specific recommendations regarding attire or footwear for the mountain?

If you go hiking (if possible, despite all the snow), I would recommend warm shoes, a warm jacket, good footwear, and accessories like beanies, scarves, and gloves. It gets quite cold up here.

Is the place accessible for wheelchair users?

The gondolas are wheelchair accessible, as is the hotel. For activities, access might be limited, but for example, the terrace is also wheelchair accessible.

How to access the gondola rides and what is the address?

The address is Schlossweg 1, 6010 Kriens. From Lucerne railway station: Take bus no. 1 (platform A) in the direction of Kriens/Obernau to the bus stop "Kriens, Zentrum Pilatus". The bus journey takes approx. 15 minutes. Then follow the red signs to the valley station in Kriens (5 minutes on foot).

Where to stay in Lucerne if getting there before Monday 19?

Here are a few Hotel recommendations at walking distance to Lucerne railway station.

- Hotel Continental, Murbacherstrasse 4, 6003 Luzern > 3min walk to the railway station.
- Hotel Waldstätterhof, Zentralstrasse 4, 6003 Luzern > 2min walk to the railway station.
- Hotel MONOPOL, Pilatusstrasse 1, 6003 Luzern > 2min walk to the railway station.
- Hotel Central, Morgartenstrasse 4, 6003 Luzern > 3min walk to the railway station.
- Hotel Des Alpes, Rathausquai 5, 6004 Luzern > 6min walk to the railway station.
