Shop Club- Shop Club is an after school club on Tuesdays. It is a way for students that are not in STEM to learn the safety and operation of the tools and create projects, or for the students that are already in STEM to deepen their understanding and create more personalized products in the shop.

<u>Art Club-</u> Students will develop skills in art making and creative thinking while fostering new relationships. Student centered activities will encourage independence and develop work habits. Activities in building with cardboard, drawing, and painting will encourage a sense of community as well as develop personal expression

<u>Jazz Band-</u> An ensemble for 6 - 8th graders where we learn about different styles of performing music (jazz, blues, swing, etc.) and perform them at each of the JSMS instrumental concerts. This ensemble is open to any instrument and is a great time for students to try out other types (drum set for percussionists, tenor, and baritone saxophone) of their main instruments. This is also a chance for students to explore their creative freedom through improvisation and section solos!

<u>Math Team</u>- Starting in December we will meet every other Tuesday after school to work on building problem solving skills on a wide range of challenging math topics. In addition, Mr. Fitch, our athletic director, is working on scheduling a few math meets so our math team can compete against other schools. This activity is for all four grade levels.

<u>Civil Rights Team</u>- The Civil Rights Team at Jordan-Small is student led, while also being part of the Civil Rights Team Project as part of the State Attorney General's Office. This means that students have voice and choice with how they meet the mission laid out by the State of Maine.

<u>Writing Club</u>- Starting this fall, Adina King will be inviting all writers to join the one and only Writing Club. Students will meet once a week for free and unstructured writing time, with the occasional sharing out. When spring hits, we will plan a night of readings, and, perhaps, a publication.

<u>Theatre Academy</u>- This is a six week theatre training that provides two tracks of experiences. The Main Stage track offers acting technique, character building, improvisation, comedy skills, audition tips, and more. The BackStage track offers opportunities to learn about everything that goes on behind the scenes including sets, props, costumes, and how to run a show.

<u>Garden Club-</u> Garden Club provides students an opportunity to work outside to plant, nurture, and harvest vegetables and other produce. Much of which is transformed into meals at Jordan-Small Middles School as well as other schools in the district.
