Isaiah 53:1-7

1 Who has believed what he has heard from us? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

2 For he grew up before him like a young plant, and like a root out of dry ground; he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him.

3 He was despised and rejected[b] by men, a man of sorrows[c] and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

4 Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

5 But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth.

6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.

7 He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him.

8 He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.

9 The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.

10 He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.

11 He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him.

12 But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,

13 who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

- 3** “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 4** “Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.
- 5** “Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.
- 6** “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.
- 7** “Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.
- 8** “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
- 9** “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons[a] of God.
- 10** “Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 11** “Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account.
- 12** Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

- 16** “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.
- 17** For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.
- 18** Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.
- 19** And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil.
- 20** For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed.
- 21** But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God.”

Unit 8 Memory Work

1 Corinthians 13

1 If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. **2** And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. **3** If I give away all I have, and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing.

4 Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant **5** or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; **6** it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. **7** Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

8 Love never ends. As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away. **9** For we know in part and we prophesy in part, **10** but when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away. **11** When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I gave up childish ways. **12** For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.

13 So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.
