**Entries** Entries for the conference meet must be entered through **Athletics.net**. The host

school shall arrange for computer seeding and scoring of the meet. After the seeding meeting, substitutions may be made only for illness or injury and will require a statement signed by the Principal or Athletic Director. There will be a seed meeting at 6:00pm on the Wednesday prior to the conference meet at a site designated by the

host school. Entries are due by 6:00 pm on Wednesday May 11, 2022.

Scoring The meet will be scored 10 - 8 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 by level. Awards will be given to the top 6 in each scoring event(medals for Varsity, ribbons for Frosh/Soph).

**Meet workers** Each school shall provide 2 qualified adult workers to work the conference meet. The host school may Pre-assign worker assignments with input from the schools. Every school is requested to provide a competent adult worker for a field event. **The Games Committee** shall consist of the Meet Manager and all Head Coaches.

### General Information

- Concessions will be open
- See the **facility map** for all field event locations.
- Please clean your team camp area at the conclusion of the meet. You may use the away bleachers as a team camp. Tents may be used on grass areas only, and as always, please secure your tents to help keep a safe meet environment.
- No tape may be used on the track. Please use chalk.
- Restrooms are located in the concession stand by the finish line. Please see the facility map.
- Admission \$5 for adults, \$3 for all students who show proper ID
- 1/4 inch spikes are permitted.

### ALL CONFERENCE

The following criteria will be used to select and determine all-conference athletes:

- 1. All outdoor DKC champions and runners up (all events) are considered automatic All Conference qualifiers.
- 2. All medalists in the IHSA State Meet
- 3. Up to eight (8) "at large" nominees voted on by each conference school's Head Track Coach. Each Head Track Coach may nominate a maximum of four (4) boys/girls from his/her team for at-large consideration. All nominees not selected All Conference shall be considered Honorable Mention All Conference
- 4. Any athlete who meets the state qualifying standard or better at the conference meet regardless of place in the conference meet (including relays).

Varsity starting Height: 1.50 m

followed by F/S starting Height: 1.45 m Increase by 5 cm on each attempt

Pole Vault: Kelly Firnbach Batavia

Varsity starting Height: 3.11 m

followed by F/S starting Height: 2.15 m. Increase by 15 cm on each attempt
