Curation tools:

When you are finding your resources for any research project, use curation tools! These can be super helpful in helping you keep track of different articles and websites and ultimately in building your Works Cited Page.

- 1. <u>Wakelet</u>: An online curation tool that will let you upload links, images, pdf's, Flipgrid, or Google files. This is one you can share and collaborate with others.
- 2. <u>Google Keep</u>: Another online curation tool that you can use to take photos, upload links, take notes, and collaborate with others.
- 3. <u>Google Docs:</u> Curate a list and collaborate with classmates by simply opening a Google Doc and creating hyperlinks above your notes.
