I. Background

To ensure you have a great experience at our Portrait Concierge Events and Visits, Portrait has specific policies in place to offer the following:

- A. Maintenance of utmost professionalism
- B. Maintenance of utmost safety
- C. Maintenance of infection control
- D. Maintenance of a proper informed consent

II. Definition

Concierge medicine is a time honored tradition and is used widely in the scope of medicine. Concierge medicine affords patient safety, comfort, and convenience and is greatly appreciated by our patients at Portrait. However, there are unique challenges that concierge medicine presents, and this document is intended to provide guidance around these challenges.

1. Event hosts must understand that ***due to the nature of an event gathering, there is a high risk that confidentiality regarding their treatment goals, medical treatment, and treatment outcomes will be known by other guests***
2. Event hosts must maintain the following standards
 - a. A clean, well-lit setting
 - b. A “treatment zone” where clients may be treated with relative privacy from the rest of the event attendees.

III. Release of Liability
