INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN

List the steps of the lesson, including instructions for the students. How will you make sure this lesson is culturally responsive?

Day 1

- Today we are going to read a story <u>Hooray for You!</u> Written by Marianne Richmond.
 Discuss how everyone is different and we all have likes/dislikes
- Take a few minutes to think about what your likes and dislikes are. I want you to share with the person sitting next to you 1 thing you like and 1 thing you do not like.
- After group discussion students will go back to their work areas and start to fill out the portion of the graphic organizer labels "Likes/Dislikes" K-1.CT.6
- Display graphic organizer on SMARTboard to demonstrate where students can locate the section

If time allows, move onto the family section.

Day 2

- Today we are going to continue learning about each other. We are going to listen to the story Families are Different by Nina Pelligrini or I like Me by Nancy Carlson
- After hearing the story students can think about who is in their family.
- Students will complete the "All about me" graphic organizer that was started on Day 1 focusing on the family section.

- Follow these steps to complete the remainder of graphic organizer

Day 3

- Today we are going to take our graphic organizers that we completed over the last several days and create a "commercial"
- Show example of video on SMARTboard- (video would be of me introducing myself including my likes/dislikes, who is in my family and what my interests are)
- Review with students where to locate the video recording icon on their iPads and discuss how the iPad will store their video they create.
- Pass out iPads-Students practice locating icon-K-L.NSD.5
- With a partner the students will take turns recording their videos using the iPad

- Bring students back together after they are finishing recording their commercials and demonstrate how to upload their commercials onto Seesaw
