*The abstract should contain a brief introduction to the study, objectives or the aims of the study, methodology used to extract data and research findings along with conclusions. The abstract should contain **no more than 300- 350 words**. Write concisely and clearly. Font style – **Times New Roman, 12pt, Italic, Text justified**.*

Keywords:

(**Times New Roman, 12pt, Bold** only the title, maximum of **5 keywords** arranged in alphabetical order leaving two-line spaces between the abstract and keywords, each keyword should start with an upper-case letter, separated by commas, followed by a single space, and a full stop at the end.)

1. Introduction (Times New Roman, 12pt, Bold with Initial Letters Capitalized,
Left- Aligned)

A full paper presents completed work and it should contain an introduction to the study with objectives, research question/questions, hypothesis, limitations and significance of the study presented in detail with separate headings.

Please **DO NOT** change the paper formatting: Paper size – **A4**, Margins – **Left 1.5 inches and all others 1 inch**, Line spacing – **1.15, single column**, Font style – **Times New Roman, 12 pt, Text justified**, Page number – **Bottom centered**.

The heading of a section and a subsection should be in **Times New Roman, 12pt, bold with initial letters capitalized**. For subsections, a word like *the* or *of* is not capitalized unless it is the first word of the heading.

All footnotes must strictly follow OSCOLA 4th Edition.

2. Literature Review

Provide a summarized and updated review of the literature about the area of study and identify the research gap.

3. Methodology

The methodology used to extract data must be clearly stated.

4. Results/Analysis and Discussion

The authors should present the results of the study and if the objectives were achieved. The findings and arguments of the work should be explicitly described and illustrated. Supporting tables, figures, and images of the results may also be included.

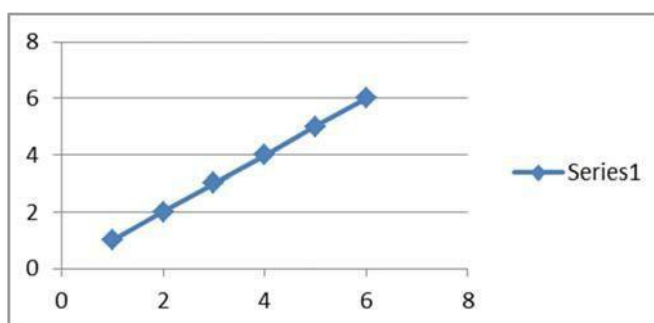


Figure 1. A linear plot.

All the tables, figures, and images should be centered. Tables, figures, and images **should be numbered** (see Figure 1 or Table 2 for an example). A **figure or an image caption** should be placed **under the figure or image** and a **table caption** should be placed **at the top**.

The word “Table”, “Figure”, or “Image” and the associated number in the caption should be in **Times New Roman, 10pt, bold**. Then, present the caption in **plain text in Times New Roman, 10pt with only the initial letter and any proper names capitalized and a full stop at the end**.

Cite the table, figure, or image if it—or its data—came from a source, using OSCOLA (4th edition) style. The word “Source” should be in **plain text - Times New Roman, 10pt and a full stop at the end**.

5. Conclusion and Recommendations

Conclusion should include if the hypothesis was proven or disproven, theoretical and/or practical implications of the study, and conclusions drawn and future recommendations.

6. Bibliography

The references should only include published material accessible to the public. Proprietary information such as internal reports may not be cited.

The references should follow OSCOLA (4th edition) style and carefully check for completeness, accuracy, and consistency. The style guideline can be found on the website.
