## Instructions

- For each question, create a slide with a good quality picture that helps show that particular topic.
- You can also include short news videos if you'd like.
- Once your presentation is ready, practice what you are each going to say and how you want to present.

## Questions to Answer in Your Presentation

1. Explain the story in 30 seconds (3 marks)
  - a. When and where exactly it happened
  - b. What happened during the disaster
  - c. What did the disaster cause
2. How were people affected by this? (1 mark)
3. How was the environment (plants, land, animals, water...) affected by this? (1 mark)
4. In what ways might this disaster be connected to climate change? (1 mark)

**Presentation** present to another group or the class (2 marks)
