Attendance Policy: Before School Music Groups

Our before-school music groups (choir, jazz band, and morning ensembles) are expected to perform in the winter and spring concerts. Additionally, these groups are smaller in size and meet less frequently than our in-school ensembles, leading to a greater emphasis on each individual's role in the group. Even just one member missing from rehearsals and performances can result in essential music parts being unfilled, and consequently creates a less-than-ideal environment for our young musicians to work in. To counteract issues we've had with attendance in the past, we are implementing an attendance policy. Failure to adhere to the attendance policy may result in your student being removed from the performance group.

Our attendance policy:

- 1) Students are permitted a **total of three unexcused absences from rehearsal per school year**. This might include over-sleeping, taking the morning off to do homework, or any absence not communicated to Mr. Weber or Mrs. Brennan in a timely manner. This does not apply to excused absences, such as doctor's visits, sickness, family emergencies, vacations, and more.
- 2) All excused absences must be communicated with Mr. Weber or Mrs. Brennan in a timely manner to be considered excused.
- 3) Students must be in attendance at the Winter and Spring Concerts, unless extreme circumstances arise (including, but not limited to, family emergencies, sickness, other unplanned tragedies, etc.) Students may not miss these concerts due to conflicts with sports schedules and other extracurricular activities.
- 4) Students who arrive later than 8:10 AM will count as an unexcused absence from rehearsal. Rehearsals begin promptly at 8:00 AM.
