For those who want to invest in Bitcoin via a 401k or IRA, you can do so through different investment firms like Fidelity with the Bitcoin ETF that was approved by the US government in January of 2024. Swan Bitcoin also offers good options for saving in Bitcoin, including IRAs. Personally, I rolled over all of my 401k savings into CoinIRA. They have great customer service and are backed by the legacy financial institution Equity Trust.

I personally use <u>Strike</u> to purchase Bitcoin, and then store it on a <u>Trezor Safe 3</u> hardware wallet. As of right now I recommend <u>Swan</u> to purchase, since the first \$10,000 of Bitcoin you buy with them is fee-free, and they offer free transfers to your external wallet.

For those who want to <u>run their own Bitcoin node</u>, I recommend getting your own Raspberry Pi 4 or later and installing <u>Umbrel</u>, which is what I've done.

For those who want to try low-cost solo Bitcoin mining, I recommend the <u>Avalon Nano 3</u>. This is also known as a "lucky miner," and can double as a space heater for your home. Learn more about solo mining in <u>this video</u>.
