Love Liberated, a Sacramento-based collective, is dedicated to fostering radical pleasure and sexual liberation within the QTBIPOC community. We are looking to build a vibrant Board of Directors committed to addressing the diverse needs of LGBTQ people of color across all demographics. We're seeking candidates with an understanding of gender identity spectrums, transgender issues, critical race theory, sexual health, and leadership experience or equivalent qualifications. Organizational skills, multitasking abilities, and the ability to work alone and with a team, along with attention to detail, are valued in potential board members. This commitment will equal around 2-4 hours a week depending on scheduled events.

Our Vision is to establish spaces that facilitate and uphold collective sexual liberation for QTBIPOC.

Our Mission is to foster sexual liberation for QTBIPOC by means of Comprehensive Education, Creativity, and Healing.

We are looking for someone who is organized and has attention to detail for this role. Your knowledge of Sacramento's venues and vendors will be helpful in collaboratively developing inclusive screening protocols. Ensuring that the events we organize represent and celebrate diverse cultures, genders, abilities, and identities. Additionally, you will work collectively to translate the organizational values into event protocols.

We encourage everyone, including women, femmes, Black/Brown, TGI, disabled, and formerly incarcerated individuals, to apply without hesitation. Love Liberated values diverse backgrounds and experiences, recognizing that unique perspectives enrich our collective mission.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be local to Sacramento
- Must be part of the QTBIPOC Community
- Act as an authentic ambassador of the organization
- Support the Board, Founder, staff, and volunteers of the agency through advisement and consultation supporting the mission and vision
- Actively commit to a 2-year term on the Board

- Commit to raise a minimum of \$150.00 “give or get” each year with the support of the development staff.
- Connect the organization to networks and resources.
- Attend at least 6 board meetings a year and one half-day board retreat.
- Attend and participate in major events, including an annual fundraising event.

DESIRED SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:

- Attention to detail and highly organized
- Familiarity with various venues and vendors in Sacramento
- Interest in collaborating with other board members as a lead in designing a vendor screening protocol for inclusivity
- Commitment to ensuring events are inclusive and representative of cultures, genders, abilities, and identities
- Ability to translate Board values into event protocols
- Assistance in maintaining a venue database with screening process results and event feedback
- Skill in delegation and close collaboration with the volunteer coordinator for task assignment
