### Remote Identification and Your Drone

Beginning September 16, \_\_\_\_\_, all drone pilots required to register their drone must operate their aircraft in accordance with the remote ID rule for pilots, which gives drone owners sufficient time to upgrade their aircraft.

Drone manufacturers have until September 16, \_\_\_\_\_ to produce drones with built-in standard remote ID.
