- Community connections
  - What skills do they have to contribute? How can they actively engage?
- Employment
- Supported employment: Model developed with employment providers
  - Flipped the typical, fee for service model: pay the employment provider for the person's hours worked, not hours they are job coached
    - Incentivizes providers to look at what are the best possible outcomes for the person
  - We continue to pay whoever is supporting that member
  - Hopefully prevents some circling through DVR
  - Encourages providers to follow best practice and get person to be as independent as possible
  - Different tiers
    - Provider gets percentage of "acuity of the member", percentage is higher in the initial stages (front loaded) and with higher needs, decreases as person is more independent
  - Helps open the conversation around natural supports (how can we increase those and fade the provider)
  - Member selects the MCO (possibly after options counseling with ADRC), then they go through their provider network
- SDS (self-determination)
  - Within Inclusa, can set up a specific person as requested by the member within their SDS team (e.g., the member wants a family member to job coach, provide transportation, etc.)
    - Especially in areas where some providers/services may not be available
- Schools should continue to direct families to ADRC
