- *Community connections*
 - *What skills do they have to contribute? How can they actively engage?*
- *Employment*
- *Supported employment: Model developed with employment providers*
 - *Flipped the typical, fee for service model: pay the employment provider for the person's hours worked, not hours they are job coached*
 - *Incentivizes providers to look at what are the best possible outcomes for the person*
 - *We continue to pay whoever is supporting that member*
 - *Hopefully prevents some circling through DVR*
 - *Encourages providers to follow best practice and get person to be as independent as possible*
 - *Different tiers*
 - *Provider gets percentage of "acuity of the member", percentage is higher in the initial stages (front loaded) and with higher needs, decreases as person is more independent*
 - *Helps open the conversation around natural supports (how can we increase those and fade the provider)*
 - *Member selects the MCO (possibly after options counseling with ADRC), then they go through their provider network*
- *SDS (self-determination)*
 - *Within Inlusa, can set up a specific person as requested by the member within their SDS team (e.g., the member wants a family member to job coach, provide transportation, etc.)*
 - *Especially in areas where some providers/services may not be available*
- *Schools should continue to direct families to ADRC*
