- **Les mots usuels:** continue with the word card rings (a reminder that these are also on the class website with audio if you are having trouble knowing how to pronounce the words.) Some kids have begun the second group of cards with an animal theme. Bravo!
- **Lecture:** have your child read and practice their book. Reading the same book several times will help your child build fluency. Please review the sounds, words and sentences in the yellow duotang as well.

Math doubles facts: We are working on learning the addition “doubles” facts. These are listed on the back of this page and could be reviewed at home to build confidence.
