Architecture enhances the human experience by creating buildings that serve and strengthen communities. The Diversity Advancement Scholarship helps build a pipeline of architects so that the profession better reflects the diverse communities they serve.

Eligible students must be a US citizen and be:

- a high school student planning to enroll in a NAAB-accredited architecture degree program;
- a rising second-year college student in a NAAB-accredited architecture degree program;
 or.
- a technical school or community college student who has completed high school or its equivalent and intends to transfer to a NAAB-accredited architecture program.

Award: Up to \$20,000

Payette Sho-Ping Chin Memorial Academic Scholarship

The Payette Sho-Ping Chin Memorial Academic Scholarship is a \$10,000 architecture scholarship supporting a woman studying architecture within a NAAB-accredited bachelor or master's degree program. To help the scholarship recipient establish contacts within the profession, she will be assigned a senior mentor from Payette for the scholarship year.

To be eligible for the Payette Sho-Ping Chin Memorial Academic Scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- Woman
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- US Citizen
- Rising 3rd or 4th year undergraduate or graduate student in NAAB-accredited architecture program

Sunia Design + Architecture Scholarship

Selection Criteria: Selected by the Dean of the School of Architecture and Planning and their delegates. The recipient must be enrolled in one of three professional programs at SA+P with at least one semester remaining before graduation, and be a member of a federally or state recognized Native American tribe. Preference will be given to eligible students who are a member of an organization that works to advance or has demonstrated experience helping women in higher education and/or the workplace. Awarded at the discretion of the Fund Administrator.

Fellows receive competitive compensation during their internship and a generous stipend for housing assistance along with living and travel support.

Award:

Round trip travel to SF or NY at start/end of the program

\$6,000 to cover travel expenses during the 3-week travel period

\$3,000 for housing assistance in New York or San Francisco during the 8-week Fellowship
\$11,000 salary during the 11-week Fellowship
