Mapping government actions supporting Ukraine's information space

Expected deliverable

- 1. A report that maps out <u>G7 Rapid Response Mechanism</u> (RRM) member government efforts to support Ukraine's information environment (including as part of interventions in the broader region). The report will include summaries for each country, which will be divided into sections listing:
 - o Government organizations involved
 - o Their level of engagement
 - o The types of interventions
 - Funding
 - Humanitarian relief
 - Policy advice and support
 - Technical and infrastructure support
 - o Any available information
 - Level of funding
 - Personnel
 - Lifespan of the particular project (including, where applicable, work that started after the Russian invasion, but that has come to an end).
 - o In addition, the report will identify themes that emerge across the countries being examined and any issues or gaps that will require further investigation by the country representatives on the RRM.
- 2. The countries under study are: Australia, Canada, European External Action Service (EU), France, Germany, Italy, Japan, New Zealand, North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), Sweden, United Kingdom, and United States.
- 3. The report's intended audience is both the RRM focal points and any senior level coordination body operating within each government and between key partners, especially on the ground in Ukraine for their validation and to address gaps.
- 4. Initially, the report will be developed using publicly available data, and will flag gaps where information is unavailable or unclear.
