7. **Team Entry Limitations:** Per Conference Rules(See attached [meet guidelines](#))
8. **Individual Entry Limitations:** Per WIAA Conference Rules
9. **Track Surface:** Track and runways are Seal Flex. Spikes up to but not exceeding **1/4"** exposed will be allowed. Random checks will be made.
10. **Throwing Circles:** Concrete with 3/4" raised rings.
11. **Weighing of Implements:** All throwing implements to be used in competition must be weighed in the "M" shed area. Legal implements will be made available to all competitors throughout the event.
12. **Team Areas:** All teams must set up outside the 4' high restraining fence that surrounds

the track. No teams will be allowed to set up inside this fence.

13. **Coaches:** No one is allowed inside of the Track or bunting on the football field. Only one High Jump coach will be allowed with their athlete(s). Upon completion of high jump all athletes and coaches must remove themselves from inside this area.
14. **Athletes:** The track will be cleared at 3:00 pm and reopen for hurdle warmup at the conclusion of the 6400 composite warmup. Track will be cleared again at 4:30pm and remain cleared for the duration of the meet. All warm-ups should take place outside the track area along the back stretch on the turf during races.
15. **Boom Boxes:** Are not allowed in the stadium.
16. **Smoking:** The Mukwonago School District is a tobacco free district. Use of tobacco products are prohibited.
17. **Concessions:** Will be available throughout the meet by The Mukwonago Boosters.

20. **Entries:** Entries are due 4/21 as per [Trackside timing](#). All entries must be done on the [milesplit](#) website. All meet information will be on the www.muktrack.com website under meet tab.
21. **Parking:** All coaches, athlete, and spectator parking should use the athletic parking lot next to the athletic complex. Busses should park in the bus parking lot east of the school (Parking lot 1). See [map](#)
22. **Jumps and Relay Markings:** Only tape is allowed for marking steps and relay exchanges. **CHALK** will not be allowed. As per bylaws, each school is to provide 1 exchange zone judge. [Race assignments](#).
23. **Pole Vault & High Jump:** Weight verification will be done before event begins. We will follow a five alive format. Starting PV height will follow the two pit procedure as per [conference bylaws](#). Coaches will be contacted after entries have been submitted in order to properly flight their jumpers. Muk will staff the 'low seed' pit (E-W)/AHS the 'high seed' pit (N-S). HJ will jump V/JV on separate pits as well (MHS will staff JV)

24. **Long and Triple Jump:** All jumpers will be open pit format and will receive 4 jumps. LJ will be followed by TJ with separate runways for V and JV
25. **Shot Put and Discus:** Throwers will be flighted by school to ensure coaches can see shot and discus. All throwers will receive 4 throws. Varsity will begin on disc, JV on shot. This will be posted on the www.muktrack.com website.
