P1 please repeat after me:

P2 please repeat after me:

I solemnly declare that I do not know of any lawful impediment why I, P2 may not be joined in matrimony to P1

Please join your hands and **P1** repeat after me.

I call on those present to witness that I, P1 take P2 to be my lawful wedded wife to have and to hold from this day forward, in whatever circumstance or experience life may hold for us.

P2 repeat after me:

I call on those present to witness that I, P2 take P1 to be my lawful wedded husband to have and to hold from this day forward, in whatever circumstance or experience life may hold for us.

Upon hearing these statements and having met the requirements of the Marriage Act of British Columbia, I pronounce you husband and wife

The government requires you must say the following-word-for-word:

P1 please repeat after me:

Now that that's cleared up, hold each others' hands and, **P1**, repeat the following after me.

P2 repeat after me:

I call on those present to witness that I, P2 take P1 to be my lawful wedded husband from now until one of us dies or does something that's grounds for divorce like try to kill one another, completely let myself go, become irreversibly boring, fall in love with some other prick, or stop giving daily gratefuls and take the other for granted.
