THE MALL, WAITING ROOM, 554, DAYLIGHT CYCLE. QUIET WAITING ROOM AMBIENCE, VERY LITTLE CONVERSATION BUT SOME ECHOING FOOTSTEPS, SOUND OF LUGGAGE ETC. OCCASIONAL ANNOUNCEMENTS OVER THE PA, SOME AUDIBLE, SOME NOT.

THE VOICE OF YUKON
Attention, Associates! Please
remember that punctuality is
productivity! It is important that
you report to all shift and ship
changes in a timely manner. After
all, delays are disappointment!
Don't be the reason a customer is
dissatisfied! You will always be
given a suitable period to

transfer between stations and routes! Be respectful of your coworkers' time! Performance strikes will be added to your file for delivery delays, based on the number of packages that arrive late, and customer satisfaction ratings. And remember! You put the Yu in YuKon!

NINE HAIDEE

(under her breath)
Filty vatnichka.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

What was that?

NINE HAIDEE

What?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

I said, what was that?

Weren't you talking to me?

NINE HAIDEE

No.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Oh. But what did you say?

NINE HAIDEE

I said it's disgusting.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Oh. What is?

NINE HAIDEE

That neftyanye.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

What--?

NINE HAIDEE

The bullshit on the comm.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Oh, the-- the YuKon announcement.

NINE HAIDEE

This is a public station. Their announcement doesn't belong here.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Why?

Pause, half-heard boarding announcements in background

NINE HAIDEE

Do you need something?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

No, no. Just..

This is my first trip like this? Across the System? And who knows when I'll get to do it again? So I want to make the most of it.

This is the biggest station I've ever seen.

NINE HAIDEE

(dimissive)

It's one of the bigger exchanges.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Oh. Uh. Sorry to have bothered you. You just--

Are you from Terminal Station?!

NINE HAIDEE

I'm sorry. What?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

The thing you said!

(awkwardly repeating and

badly mispronouncing)

Filty vatnichka. That's

Terminal-ese, right?

NINE HAIDEE

(takes a deep,
 long-suffering breath)
Terminal-ese is not a language.
English is still the primary
language there.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Oh.

But everyone says you can tell when someone's from out there because they talk weird.

NINE HAIDEE

There is an accent, yes. More distinct than yours, but no more different than that.

ANGUS SPARACELLO My accent? I just talk normal.

Pause

NINE HAIDEE

Where are you from, originally?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(a little embarrassed)

Mars.

Coletown.

NINE HAIDEE

That is in the "Rust Belt" area of the planet, correct?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

How'd you know?

NINE HAIDEE

A wild guess.

Announcement breaks in

VOICE OF YUKON

Attention, Associates! Our YuKon family is important, and you are

an important member! We encourage our family to meet in groups of three or less while in YuKon facilities and while representing YuKon. We are pleased to be able to offer after-hours entertainment programs and Refresh and Relax breaks. We ask that employees refrain from self-directed gatherings during working hours. Participation in non-sponsored events, or in recreation while one is clocked in, may result in marks against one's file, a voiding of employee benefits, or a disciplinary change in employment status or role. Remember, You put the Yu in YuKon!

Pause, then ANGUS picks back up curiously.

ANGUS SPARACELLO ...so what were you talking? I mean, if you want to tell me.

NINE HAIDEE

Makhnovchik.

ANGUS SPARACELLO What's that? Where do they speak it? Are you from Terra?

Hey! You wanna get lunch with me? I'll pay! I've got a cred card with plenty--

Clicking sound of cards

ANGUS SPARACELLO
There's gotta be someplace to eat,
right? Have you had Ganny food? I
just tried it on the ship! It's

spicy, but really good! I could--

NINE HAIDEE

You should be more careful who you speak to, and how.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

What?

NINE HAIDEE

This is not a small settlement on Mars. You cannot trust people's good natures to protect you, flashing cards like that. You should--

Cut off by announcement

VOICE OF YUKON

Attention, Associates! Please be aware that Ring 3 Concourse A through C have been closed due to excessive pedestrian traffic. All ship and shift changes have been redirected. Please check your YuKon Exclusive Employee Terminal for your updated schedule. Please be aware YuKon security has been deployed for your safety to reduce congestion.

NINE HAIDEE

(under her breath)
More owner bullshit. "Security
deployed for your safety."
Deployed to break heads.

ANGUS SPARACELLO What's wrong with YuKon? They're great! You can get anything in a Lunar day!

Well. We used to be. Before the storm. Takes way longer now.

NINE HAIDEE
They are disgusting. Wagetiffs.
(mocking repeat)

"Get anything in a Lunar day!"

Ask what cost to the worker, that anything. Ask who is stepped on. Ask what they are doing now in Concourse A through C.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Oohhh.

Are you one of those...Those labor people? Um. The illegal ones? The uh...Something...workers... movement. Or something.

I heard about them on the redline! How people were making trouble for YuKon. And how they're on their habs. And setting things on fire. Stealing stuff. They said on the news that's why YuKon hasn't gotten back to normal yet, even though the storm was months ago. People keep sabotaging stuff. It was on the redline, they were the ones who blew up all those people on those shuttles! They said—

NINE HAIDEE

They are liars! Wagetiffs, all of them.

(louder, as if giving a
speech)

The Intrastellar Workers Movement does not blow people up. We protect and fight for them! I fight for them!

ANGUS SPARACELLO

trust people's good natures to protect you.

I'm Angus. Manda sent me to get you.

Scene Break

THE MALL, CREW QUARTERS, COMPARTMENT 2-D-34. DAYLIGHT CYCLE. ATMO BACKGROUND, OTHERWISE QUIET.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Delivery! One anarchist, union-sympathizing ordnance handling expert direct from Makhnovshchina, thanks to the YuKon 24-hours anywhere in the system guarantee!

NINE HAIDEE

(scoffs)

I can assure you, they had nothing at all to do with my timely arrival. I am here entirely due to the cooperative effort of my semya and siblings.

Nine Haidee.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Manda Acterburg.

NINE HAIDEE

I have heard a great deal about you.

MANDA ACTERBURG

(annoyed)

Ugh. Yeah. People like to talk.

NINE HAIDEE

I would have thought a leader and symbol such as yourself should want to be so visible. MANDA ACTERBURG Look, I didn't ask to be one.

NINE HAIDEE

A symbol? Or a leader.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Either! All I wanted was to get back to work.

NINE HAIDEE

But the Independent Dion! The Storm-Born Revolution!

MANDA ACTERBURG

The "Storm-Born Revolution" is a name you gave after the fact, to people taking responsibility for fixing their own damn world.

NINE HAIDEE

What?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Look - let's get this straight before we get to know each other any better. I didn't want to do any of this. But it had to be done, and I was around.

People were hurt after the storm. Comms were down. We'd already had a lot of structural damage from the riots. And nothing came in from YuKon. The drones that got knocked out didn't come back online. There weren't any announcements. No one showed up from Company Headquarters. No one from YuKon management came to Dion at all. Someone had to take the lead or it would have gotten a whole lot worse for us. So I did.

And when comms come back up, everyone is on the redlines talking about how I'd "stood up and declared our freedom from capitalist tyranny." I just had a kid I wanted to have a roof over her head.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Suure. But how come you didn't just stop there? Why're you out there by Venus recruiting for the Cause? Dion got put back together months ago. YuKon hasn't touched the place since. Miriam and her moms are doing great. Face it, Manda-- you're as committed to the IWM as I am.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Look, I just don't want some idealistic, idiotic kids to get themselves in trouble.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Right.

Pause

NINE HAIDEE

What is it, exactly, that you want blown up?

Scene Break

THE MALL, CREW QUARTERS, COMPARTMENT 2-D-34. DAYLIGHT CYCLE. ATMO BACKGROUND, OTHERWISE QUIET.

Comm rings in the background. Inaudible dialogue on other side of the call

MANDA ACTERBURG

(into comm)

What?

Inaudible response

MANDA ACTERBURG

Oh yeah, got here safe and sound. Was it your idea of a joke sending it via Courier?

Everything go ok?

Inaudible response

MANDA ACTERBURG

"Getting caught on purpose" is not a plan. It's what you call a plan when the actual plan goes sideways.

Inaudible response

MANDA ACTERBURG

It'll do. He's just excited to play spy. He's just a stupid kid who's going to get himself killed. Which is why I'm still here. Speaking of here, you coming back any time in the near future?

Inaudible response

MANDA ACTERBURG

Just remember that people who play with fire get marks against their file for creating an unsafe working environment.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(in the foreground,
 speaking over all of
 Nine's attempts to speak)
What's Makhnovshchina like? That's
how you say it, right? Do you
really not have any government at
all? And no businesses? Did Dr.
Gold really live there? Do you
know him? Did you meet him?--

MANDA ACTERBURG

(cutting him off)

Angus!

ANGUS SPARACELLO

What?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Shut up!

Inaudible response on comm

MANDA ACTERBURG

(back into comm)

Will do. Stay safe, Bridger.

Manda disconnects comm in background

MANDA ACTERBURG

(to Nine)

Sorry. Just when I start to think he's taking all this seriously, I take my eyes off him for a minute, and he's back to being...that.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(whining)

I was just asking questions!

MANDA ACTERBURG

She's not here to answer your questions--

NINE HAIDEE

Please. Explain to me what we are doing here. Vissent told me you have planned an act that will strike deep into the heart of the owners and the systems of subjugation they employ. This is a public transit station.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Well, YuKon runs the entire third ring!

NINE HAIDEE

Yes. However, the third ring is connected to two other rings, one of which is a SPACE stop, the other of which houses staff. As I told you before, I do not blow people up.

ANGUS SPARACELLO
Oh! No! Of course not! I was in character when I said that. The
IWM would never hurt people!

MANDA ACTERBURG (snort of derision)

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(to Manda)

What? We wouldn't!

MANDA ACTERBURG You're going to tell me you've never taken down a MOUNTIE? What are they then? Aliens?

ANGUS SPARACELLO
No, well, that's...different!
They're...corporate!

MANDA ACTERBURG
Mmhm. Oh, sure. But maybe think a
little before you go talking about
how the good and heroic IWM
doesn't hurt people.

NINE HAIDEE

Yes. Alright. But that also does not answer the question. What is planned for demolition on a piece of public infrastructure that will harm YuKon without the population that surrounds it?

MANDA ACTERBURG Right. Yeah. Let me show you.

Scene Break

THE MALL, MAINTENANCE ACCESS TUNNEL 2-3 C78. ATMO BACKGROUND LOUDER THAN BEFORE, ELECTRIC SOUNDS, SOME MACHINE NOISE.

NINE HAIDEE

What is it we are looking at? All I am seeing is another door.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(clears throat)

That "just a door" leads to one of the most important locations in the System.

NINE HAIDEE

Yes. But what is it?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

The kind of power most people can't even imagine, one of YuKon's--

MANDA ACTERBURG

(cuts him off)

It's a YuKon production and distribution routing hub.

NINE HAIDEE

What is that?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Only the brain of the whole--

MANDA ACTERBURG

(cutting him off)

It's one of the sites where YuKon orders are processed and sent to production sites, and then allocated to couriers.

NINE HAIDEE

I-I don't follow.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Okay. So, when you place an order with YuKon or a YuKon affiliate, it doesn't just get sent straight to the fabber in some production facility on an asteroid somewhere. It gets sent to a routing hub. The hub figures out what should get made where, and sends your order to the right asteroid, and then the right Production and Fulfillment Associate. Then when they pack up your whatever, the hub decides which courier gets it, what route they follow, and in which order they do the deliveries.

The terminals inside that room manage the entire YuKon ordering logistics web for almost a *third* of the system. And YuKon handles upward of 100 million orders a day.

NINE HAIDEE

Ah, which means that if we demolish it--

ANGUS SPARACELLO

We plunge *everything* into absolute chaos!

MANDA ACTERBURG

Not everything. But a hell of a lot.

NINE HAIDEE

Well. That sounds as though it is a very worthwhile goal. How do we go about getting access?

Scene Break

the mall, the food court, beyond the Eggroll. Space station atmosphere, plus food court/eating sounds.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

This thing hurts. Maybe my ear is too small.

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

Hey, don't move your mouth so much when you talk. People are gonna notice that.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

How am I supposed to talk to you if I can't move my mouth?

NINE HAIDEE

(over comm)

As I already said, the transmitter is calibrated to pick up sub-vocalizations as well as vibrations in the jaw and cheek bone.

MANDA ACTERBURG

So keep your mouth closed!

Pause

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Do you two really need to talk to me? I can handle this. I've done this kind of thing before. Can I just talk to them on my own?

MANDA ACTERBURG

No!

NINE HAIDEE

No!

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Fine.

But don't tell me what to say unless I actually need help! I

can't focus if too many people are talking to me.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Angus?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Yeah?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Shut up.

And don't do anything stupid like get yourself arrested.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(Amused and affectionate)

Yes, ma'am.

(more businesslike)
Ok. They've sat down over there.
I'm going to move a little closer.
Find a good time to introduce
myself...

Walking, dialog here getting louder as he gets closer.

GABIJA CASTOR

So I go "If you like that you should see what I've got in my quarters." and she goes "Yeah? What?" And I go "Just a complete set of originals." And she goes "wow." And I go "Maybe if you comm me sometime, I'll show you." And she goes "Maybe I will. What's your name?" And I go "Everyone calls me Ice Hammer." And she goes--

PAYSELEY COGG

Who the hell calls you "Ice Hammer?"

MANDA ACTERBURG (over comm)

These are the so-called elite YuKon MOUNTIE Security Force?

GABIJA CASTOR

Lots of people call me Ice Hammer!

PAYSELEY COGG

I've never heard it.

GABIJA CASTOR

Lots of people do!

PAYSELEY COGG

Who?

GABIJA CASTOR

Just people, ok!

Isn't what I was talking about anyway! Dude. Why do you gotta always be such a killjoy.

PAYSELEY COGG

Whatever, Ice Hammer.

GABIJA CASTOR

Fuck you, dude.

PAYSELEY COGG

(amused)

No, fuck you.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(to comm)

Ok. I'm going to go for it. Wish me luck!

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm, sputtering)

LUCK?!

Sound of a chair sliding over.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Excuse me, friends, I believe you are fellow associates of The Org.

GABIJA CASTOR

.. the fuck is The Org?

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

Shit.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

The...uh...I thought...

(back in character)
You know. The Org. Which offers
its Associates such amazing
opportunities.

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

Ohh, nice save.

GABIJA CASTOR

I don't know what the hell you're talking about and don't want any of your opportunities--

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

We would have picked the only two MOUNTIEs on the station who are completely oblivious.

NINE HAIDEE

(over comm)

You picked them because they possess that trait.

PAYSELEY COGG

Shut up for a second, Castor, why don't you? Don't you ever listen to anyone besides the roidheads at HighG? The Org. Associates. Opportunities. You gotta pay better attention, man. Listen and learn.

(to Angus)

Yeah. Yeah. I totally am part of The Org. I'm a Gold Persistent

Sugar Maple. An associate with very high level of clearance. As is my--uh--Associate.

ANGUS SPARACELLO
Then you are exactly the
individuals I have been looking

for.

PAYSELEY COGG

Is that so. Who are you and how do you know about The Org?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Given your high clearance level, I'm sure you know about the mounting IWM threat.

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

Don't lay it on too thick.

GABIJA CASTOR

You don't have to spell it for us. We understand the words just fine.

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

For the love of--

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Uh. The Intrastellar Workers Movement.

Pause, no answer.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

The union people?

GABIJA CASTOR

Shit, don't say that kind of thing, dude! Do you want to get us all fired?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

No, no. I was just--(clears throat) To continue. I know you are aware of how dangerous the I-- the agitators can be. We have, in fact, heard that they are planning a coordinated attack on the transit hub located on this station.

PAYSELEY COGG

No shit?

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm, mocking)

No shit.

GABIJA CASTOR

How are they--

PAYSELEY COGG

Wait a minute, Castor.

(to Angus)

Who exactly are you and how are you related to The Org?

ANGUS SPARACELLO
Very good question. Exactly the sort of security-conscious scrutiny we expect from MOUNTIES.
I am Marius Taymore, Efficient Red Rocky Mountain Maple officer from the Compliance and Conformity department.

GABIJA CASTOR

C&C huh? What do they got to do with IW-whatever?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

IWM. And everything, friends.

NINE HAIDEE

(through Manda's comm)
Why is he saying he is a tree? I
had understood he was to be
identifying himself as an advanced
agent of the company.

MANDA ACTERBURG

What? Oh. Rocky Mountain Maple. It's his rank. His, his LEAF?

NINE HAIDEE

You are somehow not helping me to understand.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Your LEAF is your position in the company. Leadership trait, color, maple tree. He's saying he's important.

NINE HAIDEE

(does not get it, and
 does not want to get it)
I see.

GABIJA CASTOR

Yeah? You gonna tell us, or--

PAYSELEY COGG

Fucking shit, Castor, shut up and let him talk!

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

Seriously.

GABIJA CASTOR

Fuck you, Cogg.

PAYSELEY COGG

Shut up!

(pause, then to Angus)
You were going to say something
before my--Associate-- mouthed
off. Ignore him. He's an idiot.
So...uh...please go on?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

As I was saying, we in Compliance and Conformity have received word that the society-undermining socialists calling themselves a "labor rights movement" are planning some destructive, anti-social, and anti-capitalist strike on the hub, right here on System Exchange Station 115. We have received reliable intelligence that the people who plan to perpetrate this act are already on the station, and are, in fact, actually on company payroll!

PAYSELEY COGG

Mmhm. Ok. That sounds serious. Like a serious possible threat to security and company essential functions.

MANDA ACTERBURG (over comm, slightly relieved)

Ok. They're catching on. This might actually work.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Exactly. A very serious possible threat. Which, I assure you, management is taking seriously. But while we know they are here, we don't know who they are. Which brings me to the reason I approached you both.

We want you to help us locate the radicals.

GABIJA CASTOR ...you what?

PAYSELEY COGG ...you what?

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

They are not catching on.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

We want you to become fully deputized undercover agents of the C&C.

(pause for dramatic
effect)

MANDA ACTERBURG

Don't say it. Whatever you're going to say, don't say it.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

The Org needs you, Associates. Will you answer its call?

MANDA ACTERBURG

(over comm)

Angus. Shut up.

Scene Break

THE MALL, CREW QUARTERS, COMPARTMENT 2-D-34. NIGHT CYCLE. ATMO BACKGROUND, OTHERWISE QUIET.

NINE HAIDEE

We will need to make sure the room is empty of people.

MANDA ACTERBURG

I thought you could precision target your charges. Just take out the command terminals.

NINE HAIDEE

I can. However, even precisely targeted explosions still create an amount of flying shrapnel, and possibly corrosive gasses. While it isn't certain that there would be injuries, it's a likely possibility, and a risk I would prefer not to take.

I had thought that was the reason for the guards-- to gain access to

the room when it is usually locked and quiet. During the night cycle, presumably, when work is suspended, and workers in their quarters?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(genuinely confused) Work suspended?

NINE HAIDEE

Yes. The rest periods? Which clock does this station maintain?

ANGUS SPARACELLO
Lunar Standard. 2200 to 0700 is
the light downshift. But I don't
get what you mean, about work
being suspended.

MANDA ACTERBURG

(to Nine)

Routing hubs are 24/7 operations. Even non YuKon ones. Think of them like emergency services for capitalism.

NINE HAIDEE

Neftyanye.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Sure.

For the record, don't plan on being able to use that kind of thing to get into any company facility.

NINE HAIDEE

I'm sorry?

MANDA ACTERBURG

The "under cover of night when the shop is deserted" thing. YuKon doesn't have that.

NINE HAIDEE

They don't have night?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Deserted shops. Empty buildings. No.

NINE HAIDEE

I-- I don't understand.

MANDA ACTERBURG

YuKon doesn't run on Lunar time, or Terran time, or Gannymedeian time. It runs on all of them. At once.

NINE HAIDEE

I'm sorry?!

MANDA ACTERBURG

Nothing closes. Ever. Unless it's so damaged it can't stay open.

NINE HAIDEE

Ah.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Why would...why would something close if it wasn't damaged?

MANDA ACTERBURG

(to Nine)

He'd never been off a YuKon property til after the storm.

NINE HAIDEE

I see.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

But why would it close? Manda! Why would something be closed? That wouldn't be productive.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Anyway. Sounds like we're going to need a different plan.

NINE HAIDEE

I believe I have an idea that is likely to work.

Scene Break

THE MALL, MAINTENANCE ACCESS TUNNEL 2-3 C78. ATMO BACKGROUND LOUDER THAN BEFORE, ELECTRIC SOUNDS, SOME MACHINE NOISE.

NINE HAIDEE

(through a voice changer)
--we have planted an incendiary
device in the facility. It will
detonate at 0325, unless the
attached statement is broadcast in
full. You will not be contacted
again.

Comm disconnecting beep

ANGUS SPARACELLO

It feels kind of backward, calling in a bomb threat so we can plant a bomb.

NINE HAIDEE

I was told once that it is often best to hide the truth inside a lie that is, itself, nearly true.

Also, if they choose to broadcast the statement instead, I would still call this work a success.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Well, what's it say?

NINE HAIDEE

Ask your associate. She wrote it.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

You wrote it? Is it a manifesto?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Shut up, Angus.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

But Manda....

MANDA ACTERBURG

They're not going to broadcast it.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

But they miiiight!

MANDA ACTERBURG

They woooon't.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

But theeey--

NINE HAIDEE

(cutting him off)

There.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Uh, what's he...

NINE HAIDEE

That's one of the MOUNTIEs you "recruited," correct?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

But where's everyone else? Why's he--

Cut off by terminal ringing.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Shit.

NINE HAIDEE

Is he comm-ing?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Shut up, both of you. Nine, stay there. Keep an eye on everything. Angus, back up the access tunnel. Talk to him. Stay in character.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Uh, yeah -- uh, shit. Ok.

Feet on metal, scrambling. Comm call connects

GABIJA CASTOR

(over comm)

MOUNTIE on C&C Special Assignment Castor reporting in!

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Uh, yeah.

GABIJA CASTOR

Yeah, uh, so, someone commed us, like five minutes ago and said they're going to blow us up?

They said that they've got a bomb or something somewhere in the routing room and it's going to blow up if we don't play some bullshit statement or something? So I, I figured--Cogg and I figure--that we could let 'em blow it up. Whoever makes it out is the spy, right?

We're not gonna give in to blackmail or whatever, right? So like, we just make sure we get out, and we can be right there to take down--uh, take into custody--the survivors. Because if they don't get killed or whatever, then they've got to be disloyal. Because they knew what was going on and had a way out.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

I...how many employees do you
have?

GABIJA CASTOR

Like 30. But this'll weed 'em out really fast, you know?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Won't...uh...I mean, the Company wouldn't want to lose good associates.

GABIJA CASTOR

Associates?

(pause, laugh)
You can call a YoCol whatever you
want. They're still replaceable.
Wherever one batch came from,
there's always more. Just go to
one of the YoTowns and fill up a
ship.

ANGUS SPARACELLO Won't their families have questions?

GABIJA CASTOR

We can just tell 'em they went outside the regulations and guidelines. Getting killed is on the list of possible outcomes in the employee handbook. Plus, violating protocol's grounds for immediate revocation of any earned death benefits. Hang that over the family's heads, and no one'll say anything. It worked after that dust up on Lavigne.

Or, hell, if that doesn't work, we can just blame it on the bombers. Terrorism is basically an act of god or whatever.

They're just YoCols, why do you care, anyway? I heard C&C grinds through like hundreds a day. Wouldn't expect one of you to be so...touchy-feely.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(trying to put on a
 brutal, harsh front)
Oh. Yeah. We do. It's not the
YoCols I'm worried about. Letting
the bomb go off will simply
destroy a lot of expensive
equipment.

GABIJA CASTOR
Oh, oh yeah. Don't worry! We got
everything running under Protocol
67A Blue.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

I see.

GABIJA CASTOR

Yeah, nothin' can touch those machines. If the YoCols were smart they'd just get under 'em. Might make it through. But that'd be against protocol, and they're all such orbiters, they'd never break that. So they're just sitting there typing away. Almost feel sorry for 'em. Shoulda worked harder. Gotten promoted. Almost all of them are still at Green LEAFs, and most of them haven't even gotten to Big Tooth-Maple yet.

ANGUS SPARACELLO Protocol 67A Blue.

GABIJA CASTOR

Yeah, like I said.

(pause, then worried he's messed up, covering his butt)

I said maybe we should do 67A Delta, but Cogg insisted on Blue.

ANGUS SPARACELLO (quickly, covering his butt)

No. Blue is fine.

GABIJA CASTOR

Why are you...

(pause, then continues on knowingly)

You're being real calm about this.

ANGUS SPARACELLO
I'm not! This is just a dangerous situation!

GABIJA CASTOR Riiiiight. Right.

This is a test, isn't it.

You're testing us. You wanted to see what Cogg and I would do. If we were actually good enough to be C&C Agents.

I knew it from the beginning. I could see right through it. I could, but Cogg couldn't. I'm perceptive like that. They're just not.

Still. Real good test. I almost fell for it. Real smart.

ANGUS SPARACELLO
Yes. Of course. It's clever of you
to have figured out what I was
doing. It reflects very well on
your cognitive and observational
skills.

I knew we selected the correct people for the job. But, since you realized that this was not, in fact, an actual bomb threat, there isn't any reason to keep the exercise going.

(pretending to be talking
to someone off comm)

Shut down Scenario Kappa.

Yes, completely. The agents identified it as an exercise.

Yes, that quickly.

You're right. They are showing incredible potential.

GABIJA CASTOR

I was the one who figured it out, not Cogg.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(to Castor)

Noted.

Well. Uh. Well done. I'm sure you'll uncover the saboteur very soon.

GABIJA CASTOR

Yeah. We will.

Comm disconnect

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Mandaaaaaa.

Footsteps up corridor

MANDA ACTERBURG

So, did you screw up? Are there MOUNTIES about to break down the access hatch?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

No! Nothing like that! It's fine! It's just...just...

MANDA ACTERBURG

Spit it out.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

We're going to have to figure out another plan. To get into the hub.

NINE HAIDEE

(sigh)

Did something go wrong?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

No. I mean, yes. I mean. Sort of?

MANDA ACTERBURG

What happened, Angus?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

They weren't going to evacuate.

NINE HAIDEE

So they did not believe the threat was real?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

No. I mean. Yes?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Angus.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

I can't tell you if you keep interrupting me!

Silence for a bit

ANGUS SPARACELLO

They believed it. I think. I mean, at first. Before I started asking questions--

MANDA ACTERBURG

So you did screw up.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

I didn't! I just couldn't
believe--

NINE HAIDEE

Please tell us how the conversation went, so we may decide what needs to be done.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

(taking a deep breath)
They believed it. There was a real
bomb threat. But they weren't
going to evacuate.

They said...they said they'd just let the bomb go off, and whoever survived had to be the "spy."

So I told him it was a test.

NINE HAIDEE

What?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

I had to! He was perfectly alright letting everyone get killed! They even have a protocol for it! For bomb threats! For letting employees die! It's...awful.

MANDA ACTERBURG

After everything we've seen, this surprises you?

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Yeah! Sure, I mean, YuKon sucks and everything, but this is...wouldn't it be murder or something?

MANDA ACTERBURG

(black humor)

No. Just another workplace accident. They'd probably say it was caused by employee negligence.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

That's terrible!

MANDA ACTERBURG

YuKon is terrible.

NINE HAIDEE

Capitalism is terrible.

Pause

ANGUS SPARACELLO

What do we do now?

NINE HAIDEE

I am afraid I have no other suggestions.

Pause

MANDA ACTERBURG

I...may have an idea. But it's terrible.

NINE HAIDEE

If you think it will not work--

MANDA ACTERBURG

Not that kind of terrible.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

If it's got any chance at all, we've got to try it! For the mission! For the movement!

MANDA ACTERBURG

Alright. But just remember, I told you. It's...going to be terrible.

I need to go make a call.

Scene Break

the mall, ring 3, yukon routing hum, daylight cycle. Atmo background, computer beeps, no talking but beeping machinery

CARMINE REY

(through a speaker)
Attention, associates!! Hello!
Hello everyone! Hello Associates,
members of the YuKon family! Hello
and good day to all of you! May I

have your attention over here, please? Over here! Yes, yes, even you over there. Eyes up here, please!

Wonderful. Good afternoon, everyone, and welcome to the first day of the rest of your career!

Associates, what you are about to take part in has been provided for you exclusively by the Labor and Lifestyle Overlap for YuKon Associates Leaders Program, You have all been selected to be part of a truly special and unique experience provided by LLOYAL. One that is guaranteed to improve your mood, your work performance, and your life.

I am Carmine Rey and thiiis is HOOPLA!!!!

Audible groans

CARMINE REY

Now! The very first thing we need to do is loosen all of you up. So everyone. Staaand up! Yes, everyone! Go on! Just, just stand up right where you are!

Associates grumble, sound of chairs moving

CARMINE REY

Get up out of those chairs! Up! Up! Up! Yes, I see you, everybody up! There you go! Standing up now, and. Nowwwww. Let's shake it out! Come on, shake!

Music comes up in the background, tinny like it's in a hand-held speaker

CARMINE REY

Just like that! Let the music get into you! Let's shake, shake, shake away all those bad vibes — all that stationary, sedentary energy! Shake yourself up and awake! Let's get that bloooood pumping!

Music and sound of movement continues in background

PAYSELEY COGG

Who the hell are YOU and what are you doing here?

CARMINE REY

What are you doing here is the question. Why, you're just standing? We're supposed to be shaking!

PAYSELEY COGG

I...what? ...no...You...who? What
the, wha..

Who the hell are you and what are you doing here? Who sent you? This is a restricted, high security area!

CARMINE REY

Exactly! The higher the security clearance, the higher the stress, the higher tension, oh! The higher the need to release it! And that is what I am here for! Relaxation AND re-education!

(pause for the joke to not land, then a hearty fake laugh)

Ooh, but not like that of course! Just good old career development! Now! Are you ready to get to work?

PAYSELEY COGG

No! What...who, but...

GABIJA CASTOR

You can't just walk in here. Let me see your badge. Your ID! Your clearance!

CARMINE REY

Of course! I wouldn't dream of just waltzing into your place of work without the proper documentation! I assure you my permissions are all in order. How else could I have walked straight through that locked door? I will be sure to tell Motivation Team that my ID was thoroughly checked, despite already having passed rigorous background checks and evaluations to be employed by LLOYAL.

Here! It's my ID! Go ahead and scan it! I'm sure the Committee won't mind if the start of our program is delayed a few minutes in the name of proper security! I won't even be offended that you doubted me and the LLOYALty Committee.

GABIJA CASTOR

Oh. Um. I--I know the Committee does good checks. And I guess you did get through the security check at the door.

PAYSELEY COGG

Don't be a dumbass, *Ice Hammer*. She came in, so she's been cleared. She's *obviously* part of the LLOYAL.

CARMINE REY

Well I can tell you are an Associate with a keen and firm

sense of loyalty! I can see why, mmm,

(stage whisper)

Certain well-known Gold LEAFs

(normal voice again)
wanted me to work with this team,
if you are representative of the
kind of talent we have here.

(on speaker to the group)
Keep on shaking! The song isn't
over yet! Just really let your
limbs relax! Kick those feet! Give
me a shimmy or two! You're not
statues!

(back to Cogg)

You may, in fact, be the very individual I need! How would you like to be a team leader for today's exercises? I can tell you have the makings of a real mover and shaker!

PAYSELEY COGG

Yeah. You got that right. I got my eye on the prize.

CARMINE REY

Very good indeed! Then we have our Red Team Leader! I can only hope one as capable as you steps forward to lead the Blue Team.

(back on speaker, to the group)

Annnnnnd....stop!

Music is turned off

How's everyone doing? Feeling nice and loose? Got that energy running all through you? We're just about ready to divide up into--

GABIJA CASTOR

(interrupting)

I want the Blue Team!

CARMINE REY

I'm sorry?

GABIJA CASTOR

I want the Blue Team. I wanna run the Blue Team! I'm as good as Cogg there. Better! You can't give them a team and not me! Not unless you want everyone to suck.

CARMINE REY

(mock surprise and impressed)

Oh. I...see. Well. Then. I believe we've found our second team leader. And with that, we can get this program underway!

(back on speaker to group)

Alright, Associates! First things first! See these HOOPs? As you go by, each of you take one. When you get to the conference room, give them a shake! Shaking the HOOPs will reveal a color. This color is your team, for the rest of the program. They're going to be your family within a family!

Pause, shuffling sounds as associates moving around

Now, everyone, we're headed up the ring to conference room 3A-B33. So head right out of here, to the right. I'll be right along to open the room up and get us all going!

PAYSELEY COGG

Wait. Leave...the hub?

CARMINE REY

(laughing)

Why yes! You couldn't have thought we'd have a deep and meaningful

bonding and training experience in this tiny space, could you?

PAYSELEY COGG

But...it's a secure area?

GABIJA CASTOR

(scoffs)

Don't be a dumbass, Cogg. She's going to lock it down. I can't believe you don't know that the Motivation Team have their own overrides that let them lock and unlock ANY YuKon facility.

PAYSELEY COGG

I knew that!

GABIJA CASTOR

Then why are you asking? Don't you trust Motivation?

PAYSELEY COGG

Of - of course I do! I was just...testing...you.

GABIJA CASTOR

Suuuuuuure.

CARMINE REY

Again, this demonstration of company loyalty and inner knowledge? Oh, it is truly impressive. I admire the responsibility and ownership with which you treat your workplace! I will, of course, treat it as well as you do! I will be locking the doors behind us, so we may go on our team building journey together.

GABIJA CASTOR

See?

PAYSELEY COGG

Fuck you, Castor.

Sounds of more gathering stuff together.

CARMINE REY

Now then. If my two team leaders are ready, let us proceed to the conference room.

Door closes, lock beeps

A silent pause

Lock beeps again, door opens, footsteps

MANDA ACTERBURG

I want to say I don't believe that worked. But of course it worked.

NINE HAIDEE

Who was that person? Are they, in fact, who they said they were?

MANDA ACTERBURG

Oh, if you mean are they a (voice trying to mimic Carmine)

An enthusiastic supporter of better mental health through physical well-being? Then yeah. They are. If you mean do they work for YuKon, then no. They very much do not. Anymore.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

They were amazing.

MANDA ACTERBURG

You would think so.

Pause while everyone adjusts

MANDA ACTERBURG

Well. We're in. What do we do now?

NINE HAIDEE

You stand there, out of the way. This is where my work begins.

Footsteps away, NINE goes to work on setting up explosives in the background

ANGUS SPARACELLO So, uh, how do you know them?

MANDA ACTERBURG Oh, Carmine?

ANGUS SPARACELLO
Yeah. They...um...don't seem like
the kind of person you'd...uh... I
mean, they...

MANDA ACTERBURG Yeah. They.

I met them when we were both still working for the company. Got them out of some trouble. They used to be a Monty.

ANGUS SPARACELLO
He is not like any MOUNTIE I've seen before...

MANDA ACTERBURG
Not MOUNTIE. Monty. As in Monty
the Moose? YuKon's family-friendly
brand ambassador mascot? They'd
get all dressed up in this
ridiculous cartoon moose suit, and
go around to different YoTowns
MCing for Associate events. You
know, fairs, graduations, Shipping
Goal Achievement parties, stuff
like that. They were, if you can
believe it, the most-asked-for
Monty in the System.

ANGUS SPARACELLO
Ohhhh. I forgot about that! Monty
the Mountie Moose! I haven't seen

him since I was a kid! He used to be everywhere. I can't believe I didn't remember! Whatever happened to them, anyway?

MANDA ACTERBURG Uh, Carmine happened.

Let's just say that YuKon doesn't like it when anyone goes off brand, much less their most well known character. And they really don't like it when said character starts sounding a little red.

ANGUS SPARACELLO What does that mean?

MANDA ACTERBURG Hey, Nine, did you ever meet Xash? Xash Boyle?

NINE HAIDEE Yes. She was a kind, genuine person. And such a beautiful voice.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Who?

MANDA ACTERBURG
Opera singer, and people who know about that kind of thing said she was a good one. But what's important to the matter at hand is that she was born on Makhnovshchina.

ANGUS SPARACELLO I'm not really following this story...

MANDA ACTERBURG
To sum up-- Carmine, YuKon's
favorite Monty Moose fell for
Xash, an anarchist and true

believer. So they had to go. Even if they hadn't converted to her way of thinking, being married to an anti-capitalist is a pretty big deal to the biggest commercial enterprise in the system. So they were found in breach of contract, and out they went.

NINE HAIDEE

(under her breath)

Neftyanye.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Of course. Anyone who challenges the Almighty Acquisition of Income must be punished.

So you saved them?

MANDA ACTERBURG

I just helped a person out of a bad spot. I didn't know it was political.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Suuure. I knew it, Manda. You've been a supporter of The Cause all along. You're a Unioneer with the heart of a hero!

MANDA ACTERBURG

No. I don't.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Do.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Don't.

ANGUS SPARACELLO

Do.

Chime as the bombs activate

NINE HAIDEE

(cutting them off)
I am finished. We should get out
of here. Quickly, please.

MANDA ACTERBURG

Right. Yeah. Just a second. There's something I need to do.

NINE HAIDEE

Alright. But hurry. The timers on these devices have already been set.

MANDA ACTERBURG

I got it. I'm right behind you.

Footsteps.

MANDA ACTERBURG

(to herself)

Ok. Comm terminal...comm terminal... are - are these all comm terminals? Ok. Those are company...how about... Ok. Blueline. That works.
Aaand...Redline. Perfect. This'll do.

Pause, beeping, clicking, computer stuff

MANDA ACTERBURG

'The heart of a hero"? No, Angus. I'm not a hero. I don't want to be. But someone has to do something. Someone has to help make things better. And until someone better, someone who really does have the heart of a hero comes along, you're stuck with me.

Final beep of recording being uploaded

Scene Break

YORK VENTURA

Order system shutdowns? Production halts? Delivery delays? What's

wrong at YuKon? Company President Preston Jorgensen declines to comment. This is York Venture, for Redline U838, the Voice of the System.

The past 24 hours have seen a truly unbelievable development in intra-stellar commerce-- YuKon, known throughout the System for its "anywhere in 24" quarantee, repeatedly failing to deliver. We have received reports from locations ranging as widely as Terminal Station and Golden City, Mercury, indicating that expected orders, some already far outside 24 hour quarantee, have still not arrived, and there has as yet been no communication from the company as to when they can be expected. Though officially denied by company representatives, reliable sources say that pro-Union activists representing the Intrastellar Workers' Movement have caused this service disruption by--

THE VOICE OF YUKON (cutting in)

Attention, Associates! Remember! Information literacy is vital! We want to equip our YuKon family with the tools you need to be discerning consumers and contributors! Please take note of not only what is reported, but who has provided the information in that report! After all, even "unbiased news" can include the prejudices designed to sway the listener. Demand transparency! Accept no information without a clearly identified source!

YuKon is pleased to offer the most comprehensive employment security package in the System, and we have no intention of reducing the benefits we offer to our associates. You are our greatest resource, and we are your biggest fans! But please, we can only support you as far as you will let us! The circulation of gossip and unsubstantiated rumors undermines our efforts to raise up each and every Associate into the very best version of themselves. Refuse to allow it! Stop the lies in their tracks! Report any misinformation to your Associate Liaison! Have questions? Ask us directly! Company representatives stand by on Company Whiteline 44395 to clear up any--

Broadcast crackling and breaking up. Yukon announcement jingle

MANDA ACTERBURG (recording, breaking into comm broadcast)

Attention, Associates! Everything that you just heard is bullshit. We know that. Everyone knows that. But no one ever says it out loud. So I think it's time someone did.

Yeah, it was the IWM. We destroyed the SE115 YuKon Routing Hub. No one was hurt, and if they tell you someone was, that is αlso bullshit.

We did it. But we didn't want to. None of us want to be doing this. Some of us pretend they do. Some of the young might even think they do. But if you gave any of our so-called revolutionaries the chance to be at home, with families and loved ones, secure, and protected, and unconscious, they'd be lying if they said they wouldn't take it. But we can't. Because we know what's happening. Because we've seen the pain, and the fear, and the death that they cause. And we've seen it be called "progress."

How many of you really know what it's like to work for YuKon? How many of you are going to just shrug and say well, that's just how things work. You take a job knowing what you're going to have to do. And if you don't like it, find something better.
