Paraprofessionals

Work directly with children, early childhood age 3 through 8th Grade, in a classroom setting. Assist teachers in providing appropriate educational experiences to students. Pay: \$15 per hour worked (Pre-k, EC and 1:1 = \$15.75 per hour worked).

Food Service

Work in the kitchen preparing and serving meals to school aged children, as well as clean-up. Early morning to early afternoon hours. Pay: \$15 per hour worked.

Custodian

Clean and disinfect classrooms, bathrooms and hallways. This may include sweeping, vacuuming, mopping, emptying trash and other duties as assigned. Morning, afternoon and evening hours. Pay: \$15.00 per hour worked.

Nurse

You will deliver proper and efficient health services to students who are sent to the nurse's office for care. Must hold an active RN license with the State of Illinois. Pay: \$27 per hour worked.

Secretary

Direct substitutes, volunteers and all visitors who enter the office. Handle incoming calls, daily attendance and other duties as assigned. Pay: \$15 per hour worked.

Certified Teacher Sub Positions (Click here: [Application](#))

As a Substitute Teacher in our school district, it will be your mission to ensure and carry out the teaching performance responsibilities for the benefit of all students within the district.

In order to begin substitute teaching, you must hold one of the following licenses:

- If you hold a bachelor degree of any kind from an accredited college or university, you can then substitute teach with either a PEL, Substitute Teaching License, or a Paraprofessional license that is registered with the Boone-Winnebago County Regional Office of Education #4.
- If you are actively enrolled in an approved Illinois educator prep program through a regionally accredited institution in Illinois, have completed within the semester at least 90 credit hours as part of the program and have a PEL in pre-completion status through ELIS, you can apply for a SUB teacher license
- You can obtain a Short-Term Substitute (STS) Teaching License with an associate's degree or have completed at least 60 credit hours from a regionally accredited institution of higher education. This is only valid for 3 years and you must complete training within our district before you can start subbing.

Pay rate: \$125 per day or \$62.50 per half day PLUS we will pay the 9% TRS contribution on your behalf or, if retired, we will pay you the 9% TRS contribution in addition to your wage.
