

Alcohol and Tobacco (Nicotine/Vaping) Discipline Policy

Students are not to possess, use, sell or distribute alcohol/tobacco/tobacco alternative products on school property, including school buses, nor at school sponsored activities under the supervision and sponsorship of the school personnel.

First Violation:

- Call parent with the student present
- One day of in-school suspension
- Student must complete a one to two hour after school alcohol/tobacco education program designed/administered by DFC director within 30 days from violation
- If student does not complete education program within 30 days student's name will be given to Resource Officer to file charges

Second Violation:

- Call parent with student present
- Two days of in school suspension with a two hour after school education component designated by DFC director
- The student will complete 8 to 10 weeks of an alcohol/tobacco education program designated/administered by the DFC director.
- Failure to complete the education program will result in charges being filed by the school Resource Officer

Third Violation:

- Call parent with the student
- Referral to Hillview
