DImportant Notes:

- 1. To find specific Pokémon quickly use the search function (CTRL + F for Windows / Q on Mobile)
- 2. If you have questions **regarding the spawns** of those, type !spawn in the <u>AllTheMons</u> Discord
- 3. Ask Cobblemon related questions in the <u>Cobblemon Discord</u> and Mega Showdown ones in the Mega Showdown Discord.
- 4. Do not use AllTheMons x Mega Showdown in combination with **any** of these add-ons, this could cause many serious issues. They are all already in AllTheMons so there's no reason to use them in the first place. Check the **Compatibility section** on Modrinth for more info
- 5. Every Pokémon on that list is obtainable without cheats in some way, shape or form, be it through natural spawning, using the resurrection machine, evolving it or changing its form.
- 6. This list is **always** updated to the **latest** version of AllTheMons x Mega Showdown

Use (right-click) Honey Comb on Applin

Hydrapple:

Use (right-click) Dragon Breath on Dipplin or teach him Dragon Cheer via TMs

Archaludon:

Use (right-click) Metal Coat on Duraludon

Kingambit:

Defeat 3 other Bisharp with your Bisharp

Melmetal:

Give Meltan 75 Meltan Items to eat (you get one by releasing a Meltan)

Put a Nether Star & Psychic Gem in the machine

Armored Mewtwo (Binding Armor):

Changes:

Typing: Psychic & Steel

Ability: Battle Armor (prevents the opponent from landing a critical hit)

Additionally learns: Metal Claw, Iron Defense, Iron Head, Bullet Punch, Screech, Smart

How to obtain:

Use *(right-click)* a Binding Armor on it Reversible with the same item

Mega X & Y forms)

How to obtain:

Use *(right-click)* a Shadow Energy on it Reversible with the same item

Shadow Mewtwo Mega Y (Shadow Mewtwonite Y):

Stats: +20 offensive, -20 defensive stats

Typing: Psychic & Dark

Ability: Shadow Shield (take half DMG when full HP)

How to obtain:

Shadow Mewtwo has to hold Shadow Mewtwonite Y



Shadow Lugia (Shadow Energy):

Changes:

Stats: Swapped offensive and defensive stats

Typing: Dark & Flying

Ability (Regular): Dark Aura (boosts dark type moves by 33%)
Ability (Hidden): Shadow Shield (take half DMG when full HP)

Additionally learns: Shadow Sneak, Pursuit, Taunt, Feint Attack, Snarl, Payback, Nasty

Plot, Night Shade, Night Slash, Dark Pulse, Sucker Punch, Night Daze

How to obtain:

Use (right-click) a Shadow Energy on it

Reversible with the same item



Primal Dialga (Time Gear):

Changes:

Stats: HP: 100, ATK: 140, DEF: 140, SP ATK: 180, SP DEF: 110, SPD: 110

Ability: Full Metal Body (Stats can't be lowered by opponent)

How to obtain:

Give it a Time Gear to hold Reversible by taking the item off of it



Virus Groudon (Corrupted Wish):

Changes:

Stats: HP: 113, ATK: 97, DEF: 130, SP ATK: 147, SP DEF: 113, SPD: 70

Ability 1: Thermal Exchange (raise ATK when hit by fire moves, can't be burned)

Ability 2: Earth Eater (restores HP when hit by ground moves)

How to obtain:

Use (right-click) a Corrupted Wish on it Reversible with the same item



Galarian Mega Slowbro (Slowbrogonite):

Changes:

Stats: HP: 95, ATK: 130, DEF: 115, SP ATK: 130, SP DEF: 90, SPD: 30

Ability: Shell Armor (same as regular Mega Slowbro for now)

How to obtain:

Galarian Slowbro has to hold Slowbrogonite



Spiky Eared Pichu (Ancient Light Ball):

Changes:

None, it's purely cosmetic

How to obtain:

Use an Ancient Light Ball on a **female** Pichu
