References should be numbered consecutively and placed in the text as superscript arabical numeral surrounded by square brackets.^[1] Use the "REFERENCES" (Times New Roman, 7,5pt single spaced, left aligned) syntax to write the bibliography.

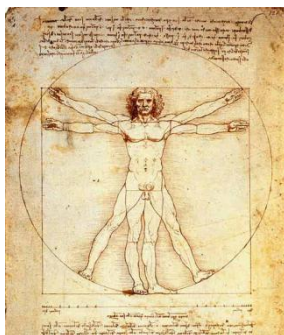


Figure 1. Figure caption example
