## **Key Unit Questions:**

## Development and Codification of Religious and Culture Traditions

- How did codifications and further developments of existing religious traditions provide a bond among the people and an ethical code to live by?
- How did new belief systems and cultural traditions emerge and spread, often asserting universal truths?
- How did belief systems affect gender roles?
- What religious and cultural traditions continued parallel to the codified, written belief systems in core civilizations
- How did artistic expressions, including literature and drama, architecture, and sculpture, show distinctive cultural developments?

## **Development of States and Empires**

- How did the number of key states and empires expand dramatically by imposing political unity on areas where previously there had been competing states?
- How did empires and states develop new techniques of imperial administration based, in part on the success of earlier political forms?
- What were the unique social and economic dimensions developed in imperial societies in Afro-Eurasia and the Americas?
- How did the Roman, Han, Persian, Mauryan and Gupta empires create political, cultural, and administrative difficulties that they could not manage, which eventually led to their decline, collapse, and transformation into successor empires or states.

#### **Emergence of Transregional Trade/Communication Networks**

- What enabled land and water routes to become the basis for transregional trade, communication, and exchange networks in the Eastern Hemisphere?
- What new technologies facilitated long-distance communication and exchange?
- How did trade help to disseminate goods, aid the exchange of people, technology, religious and cultural beliefs, food crops, domesticated animals, and disease pathogens developed across far-flung networks of communication and exchange?
