



Repeat steps 2-5 for all invalid course codes found in step 1.







1. Verify that all students have a UID.
 - 1.1. Go to **Registration > Utilities > Texas Unique Student ID Processing > UID Export**
 - 1.2. Select **Missing UID Report**
 - 1.3. If any students are listed on the report, **see Step 2.**




2. Assign students UID
 - 2.1. Select **UID Assignment**
 - 2.2. Click **Execute**
.txt file will be downloaded
 - 2.3. Click **OK**
 - 2.4. Complete the TSDS Assign UID Process in TSDS. See "Assign IDs via Batch File" in the [TSDS Unique ID User Guide](#).
 - 2.5. Go to **Registration > Utilities > Texas Unique Student ID Processing > UID Import**
