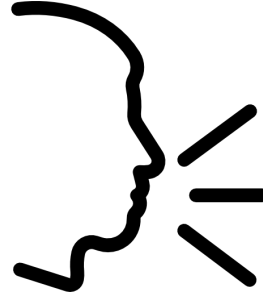

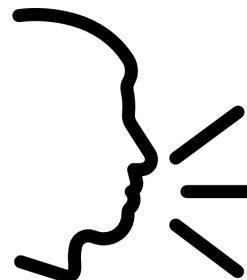

The first product, a brake-pedal pad, is being field tested on fleets of police cars, rental cars, and taxicabs. -[4]- Each recycled tire can produce 250 brake-pedal pads.

Getting the right octane level in gasoline—a key to engine performance—is costly because of current evaluation methods. -[1]- To ensure compliance with government regulations, refineries add more octane than necessary. Now an oil company based in Ashland, Kentucky, has developed a more accurate testing technique.

-[2]- The new procedure, which is called InfraTane, instead uses infrared light to assess octane levels. Different molecules absorb light at specific frequencies, so by measuring the amount of absorbed light, refiners can evaluate octane levels and adjust them online to achieve the proper mix.

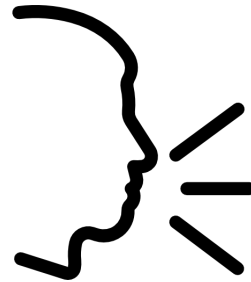
-[3]- InfraTane has been installed in the company's St. Paul, Minnesota, refinery and will save more than \$1 million a year. -[4]- InfraTane has been licensed to a firm in Merrick, New York, that is expected to offer it to other refineries around the world for around \$300,000.

AMERICAN IMPRESSIONISM AND REALISM

A Landmark Exhibition from the Met

Exclusive to the Western Australia Museum of Art in Perth is the exhibition “American Impressionism and Realism: A Landmark Exhibition from the Met.” This exhibition presents 71 paintings by 34 artists from New York’s Metropolitan Museum of Art. –[1]– Among them are some of the Met’s best examples of paintings in the American Impressionist and Realist traditions, many of which have never before been displayed outside their home in New York.

Leading figures — such as Impressionists John Singer Sargent, Mary Cassatt, Childe Hassam, and William Merritt Chase, and Realists Robert Henri, John Sloan, and William Blackins — are represented by several works. –[2]– The exhibition considers how proponents of two styles that flourished around 1900 responded artistically to modern life in very different fashions.

More than 30 iconic Australian paintings from those two schools that also flourished in Australia during the early twentieth century are also to be included in the exhibition. –[3]– They include works by artists such as Tom Roberts, Charles Conder, and Frederick McCubbin.

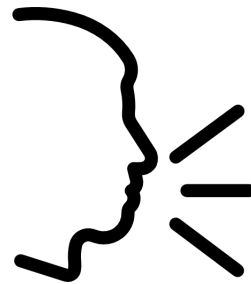
