Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- teaching content using an interdisciplinary, project-based approach whenever possible and appropriate.
- teaching, enriching, and extending the NC Standard Course of Study.
- developing effective lesson plans and instructional materials.
- providing personalized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student.
- using a variety of creative and engaging instructional strategies, such as inquiry, student-led discussions, and project/problem-based learning to promote critical thinking, student agency, and leadership skills.
- infusing social-emotional learning into the daily instructional program.
- establishing and maintaining standards of student behavior necessary in achieving an optimal learning atmosphere.
- using both formative and summative assessment strategies to evaluate students' academic growth and adjust instruction accordingly.
- keeping appropriate/accurate records and preparing progress reports and report cards.

- communicating with parents through conferences, phone calls, and/or emails to develop trust and discuss students' progress.
- collaborating and planning regularly with other social studies teachers.
- serving as an integral member of the 5th grade team.
- continually seeking opportunities to grow professionally through in-service education activities.
- performing other duties as assigned by the school administrators.
