

SUBJECT + VERB

I love coffee I drink it every day. - **RUN-ON SENTENCE** -> WRONG

I love coffee, I drink it every day. - **COMMA SPLICE** -> WRONG

I love coffee. I drink it every day. - Correct

I love coffee, **so / and** I drink it every day. - **Compound** (CORRECT)

One independent clause/sentence, SO (conjunctions: **FANBOYS** -> FOR, AND, NOR, BUT, OR, YET, SO) + **another independent sentence.**

I love coffee; **therefore**, I drink it every day. - *therefore = that's why*

As / Because / Since I love coffee, I drink it every day. - **Complex sentence (CORRECT)**

I drink coffee every day because I love it. - **CORRECT**

As = Since = Because

Wrong: I'll stay at home today. Because I'm sick.

Right: I'll stay at home because I'm sick. (it should be one complex sentence)

Because I'm sick, I'll stay at home. (OK)
