An Amish Barn Raising Square

Welcome to the **Read and Crochet Along (RCAL)**. If you love reading and crochet, this CAL is for you! Each square is inspired by one of my books and has an accompanying tutorial.

The pattern is customizable. Use any size yarn, type of yarn, and any size hook. You can make a small, medium, or large square by subtracting or adding rounds/using a smaller or larger hook. You can also reverse the order of the colors or use different ones. It's up to you! It's also a great scrap yarn project.

Materials used for the pictured square are below.

- Red Heart Super Saver Yarn in **Delft Blue, Light Jasmine, Orchid, Baby Pink**
- US **H** Hook (or hook recommended for yarn or hook you've been using for previous granny squares)
- A stitch marker (SM)- one to mark the BOR/first stitch
- Scissors
- Yarn needle to weave in ends
- Measuring tape or ruler

Square measures approximately 5 in. x 5 in. Gauge not necessary for this project.

Abbreviations:

sc: single crochet

st(s): stitch(es)

dc: double crochet

ch: chain

SM: stitch marker

FO: fasten off

slst: slip stitch

Notes: Ch1 does not count as a stitch. First sc is always worked into the same st as the slst join. You may wish to mark the first st with a SM for clarity.

Pattern:

With Delft Blue, ch 5, slst join to make a ring, do not pull tight or weave in yet- leave a hole for now, ch 1.

Round 1:

Working all sts into the ring, (sc 1, ch 11, slst join into the back bump of the 10th chain from the hook, ch 1, sc 1) x4, slst join into top of first sc, ch 1. - 8 sts, 4 loops

Round 2:

(sc 1, sc in sp, ch 3 behind the loop from previous row, sc in sp, sc 1) x4, slst join into top of first sc, and fasten off. - 16 sts, 4 ch 3 spaces

Round 3:

Join Light Jasmine in same st, ch 1, (sc 2, sc 1 in ch sp, ch 11, slst join into the back bump of the 10th chain from the hook, ch 1, sc 1 in ch sp, sc 2) x4, slst join into top of first sc, ch 1. - 24 sts, 4 loops

Round 4:

(sc 3, sc in sp, ch 3 behind the loop from previous row, sc in sp, sc 3) x4, slst join into top of first sc, and fasten off. - 32 sts, 4 ch 3 spaces

Round 5:

Join Orchid in same st, ch 1, (sc 4, sc 1 in ch sp, ch 9, slst join into the back bump of the 8th chain from the hook, ch 1, sc 1 in ch sp, sc 4) x4, slst join into top of first sc, ch 1. - 40 sts, 4 loops

Round 6:

(sc 5, sc in sp, ch 3 behind the loop from previous row, sc in sp, sc 5) x4, slst join into top of first sc, fasten off. - 48 sts, 4 ch 3 spaces

Round 7:

Join Baby Pink in same st, ch 1, (dc 6, dc 2 in ch sp, pull Light Jasmine loop through the Delft Blue loop, pull the Orchid loop through the Light Jasmine loop, dc around Orchid loop and ch

together, dc 2 in ch sp, dc 6) x4, slst join into top of first dc, and fasten off. Tighten ring as much as needed for square to lay flat. Weave in all ends and block if desired.
