1. **Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance:** Mr. Carini called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
2. **Recognition of Service:** Board Member Elizabeth Sparks was recognized for her service on the Board.

3. **#9463-0618** Ms. Schreiber Johnson moved and Mr. Verhalen seconded to approve coverage for liability, commercial crime, workers compensation, environmental hazards and property as presented for the 2018-19 school year with EMC. **Motion passed.**
4. **#9464-0618** Ms. Schreiber Johnson moved and Mr. Verhalen seconded that the Board grant authority to Andrew Chromy, the Chief Business and Finance Officer, and Timothy Culver, Superintendent, to enter into purchase and sale agreements in relation to selling or purchasing real estate for the Knight Construction Program, subject to sharing information with the School Board and approval by electors, as required by state statute. **Motion passed.**
