



In the case of wet or stormy weather

If there are periods where it is unsafe to be in the field due to severe weather conditions, there will be a range of presentations and workshops offered in the Rainbow Beach Community Hall by the scientists who are the Team Leaders. Please bring appropriate clothing, headwear and footwear for wet conditions as a little rain won't keep us out of the field. A simple poncho fits well over backpacks in the field and fits easily into your backpack. You can check the weather before leaving home using the 5 day forecast from the Bureau of Meteorology or Willy Weather (weather and tides).
