Word of the Day: **crucible** *noun* | **KROO-suh-bul** *Crucible* refers to a

place or situation that forces someone or something to change. Most commonly found in formal and literary writing, it can also mean “a difficult test or challenge.” Its original meaning, still in use, is “a pot in which metals or other substances are heated to a very high temperature or melted.” EXAMPLE SENTENCE: Her rock-solid songwriting skills were forged in the *crucible* of the Nashville music scene.
