Overview: This year we will be learning about geometry, ratios & proportions, numbers & operations, expressions & equations, and statistics & probability. We will be using the North Carolina Collaborative for Mathematics Learning (NC²ML) Mathematical Framework. We will be using **Canvas** as our digital platform, as well as a variety of google tools.

Expectations: Students are expected to be on time and prepared with materials. Students are expected to participate, work cooperatively, and complete work on time. All students are to show their work on all problems, including homework. **No Work = No Credit.**

Above everything else, students are to show respect, be kind, and bring a positive attitude to class.

Negativity and disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.

Leaving the room: Only in an emergency, NOT during direct instruction. Students must have a pass. Students can not leave the classroom the first or last 10 minutes of class.

Absent: When absent, it is the student's responsibility to get and make up any missing assignments

Consequences: Consequences for misbehavior or cheating may result in, but are not limited to: verbal warning, parent/guardian contact, student conference, parent conference, and even an office referral.

Homework: I will give homework nightly for students to practice the skills we are learning in class. This is usually 5-10 problems. HW is checked daily for completion and accuracy.

Grading Guideline:

Tests- 35% of grade

Quiz - 30% of grade

Guided Work (CW)- 25% of grade

Homework- 10% of grade

Grading Scale:

90-100%= A

80-89%= B

70-79%= C

60-69%= D <60%= F

Late Work Policy: Students are expected to complete classwork the day it is assigned, but will be given until the following day to submit with the expectation that it is completed during Spartan Time or at home. Students will have until the end of the unit to turn in work for that unit. All tests and quizzes will need to be completed AT SCHOOL and cannot be made-up at home. Late homework will not be accepted.

Class Website/PowerSchool: The Supernova website can be found on the Salem Middle School homepage under the "Students" tab. The website includes daily assignments and our team's homework assignments. I try to update PowerSchool **weekly** and parents and students should be checking it regularly.

Suggested Materials used in Math: Pencils, headphones/earbuds, colored pencils, BIC retractable pen. Students will be given math packets to take notes in, show their work, complete practice problems and homework assignments. These will be kept in their RED folder and cleaned out at the end of each unit.
