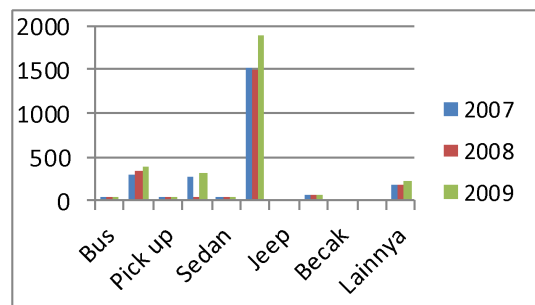

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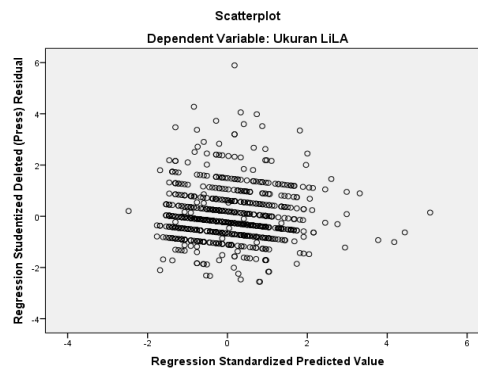
**Figure 1.** STIKES Fatima Parepare Building.

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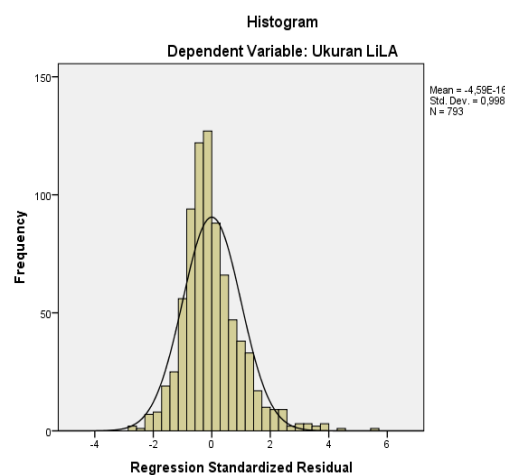
**Figure 2.** Distribution of Traffic Accident Rate.
