Error: ScratchJr can't be opened because the application "can't be trusted" Solution:

If you are on a Mac you may have trouble opening up the application because it is not from the App Store. If you are having trouble getting ScratchJr to open up, you will need to go to your System Preferences then click on Security and Privacy. From there click on the General tab and then under the section that says "Allow apps downloaded from" choose the selection that says App Store and identified developers. If you can't make that selection, click on the lock icon in the lower left corner, type in your password and then it should allow you to make the selection.

Error: In Scratch, I created a drag and drop interaction, but it's only working for one color.
