High-level Strategy Calendar

If you are struggling to balance and combine different types of posts within your overall strategy of message pillars. Think first about what types of content work for the different message pillars.

Posting Post-Opening Celebration

Now that the opening celebration is over, you may be wondering, what do I post now?

Review the 3-week calendar overview we delivered last month and you'll recognize that you can utilize this and your exhibition/event calendar for the museum to easily put together frequent and consistent posts for social media.





Museum Events

- March 13–April 22: 2023 Student Art Exhibition | Cultivate (or Community)
- May 23–September 16: The Art of Belonging | Community
- Date X: Private event | Community (Or Cultivate depending on the event)
- Date Y: wedding | Connect
- Date Z: Student Event A | Connect

You can see the events categorized (in the green text) by message pillar to determine how you think they can fit into your calendar.

Post Ideas

I've made numerous bullet points in each category that not only relate to the museum events above but also fit into the 3-week calendar strategy categories.

With this calendar strategy, you can easily make posts for months on end! Cultivate

- How a student in the student exhibition has cultivated their artistic talent this semester
- Ideas on how an artist (or inspiring artist) can cultivate their talent
- Activities the museum is hosting to help people cultivate their talents
- Timelapse video of student art classes working to cultivate their talents
- Historic facts about famous artists and how they cultivated their talents
- Poll: you can ask how your audience cultivates their talents
- Creative challenge: Share weekly or monthly creative challenges on social media. These could include prompts for writing, photography, painting, or any other art form
- Student highlight: Highlight emerging artists and encourage followers to support them by attending their exhibitions, purchasing their work, or sharing their posts on social media

Connect

- inspirational quotes and stories and find a connection in the world around them
- Partnering with other artists, galleries, or museums on projects
- Poll: ask people what their thoughts on a popular art piece are
- Find connections people can have with art in their daily lives (murals, postcards, etc.) So much of the world around us is from artists. What are those things?
- Share posts that celebrate diversity (in connection with *The Art of Belonging* exhibition)
- Highlight UGC from people that have attended the museum





Building Stronger Communities

- Partnering with other artists, galleries, or museums on projects
- Highlight artists in The Art of Belonging by event sharing once a week or so, I'm sure
 you'll have posts for awhile
 - You could take this one step further and do interview videos about their art piece(s) in the exhibition
- As people come to the exhibition (especially from the opening celebration) collect quotes and testimonials from them. Then, you can tag them if they are willing and share their words
- Ask the audience to share a post that celebrates the diversity in art and encourages your followers to share art pieces from their own culture. Use the hashtag #ArtDiversity and tag the museum
- Share a post that features a popular art piece from a different era or style and ask your followers to share their favorite modern interpretation of it. Use hashtag #artthroughtime
- Share that the museum is free admission and therefore bridging art to the community for everyone!
- Ask community members to submit work to the next or future art exhibitions

Using Analytics to Optimize

Without analytic access, I can't give customized optimization suggestions. However, utilizing all that we've discussed in these consulting documents, you will want to review your analytics side-by-side with your 3-week calendar and look at what is working and what posts are performing well, and what isn't. Remember, there are lots of variables. So try things a couple of times before you decide to move on.

Variables that should be reviewed in analytics are:

- Video vs. static photos
- Questions in captions or specific CTAs vs. lots of text without CTA
- Long vs. short captions
- Day or week or time posted can affect engagement
- Use of emojis or not
- Photography style (use of people, incorporation of art, filters, etc.)

The Kiss (sculpture pictured) by Rodin is a timeless masterpiece in the art world! He But here's a juicy fact: few people know that it was originally titled "Francesca da Rimini" after the character in Dante's Inferno.

Francesca, captivated by her husband's brother Paolo, is beautifully portrayed in this sculpture just moments before their ill-fated kiss. Rodin deliberately kept their lips apart, symbolizing the impending doom that awaits them.
