Getting to Know The Student	
What do the Present Levels of Performance tell you about this student?	
Does this information match how you've observed the child perform in your class so far?	
If so, how? If not, where are there disconnects?	
How might you work with peers to gather additional information to form a more robust understanding of the student?	
Creating Classroom Connections	
List the accommodations, modifications, and classroom strategies that the IEP mandates for this student.	
What other strategies might help this student?	
How might these strategies benefit other students?	
What is the plan for incorporating these strategies into your instructional planning?	
Using a Team Approach to Maximize Growth	
How might you support this student's progress on IEP goals in your classroom? How can/do the skill areas connect with grade-level content?	
At a minimum, when will you review the IEP throughout the year?	
How will you remember to revisit the student's goals when needed?
