Lightning Body Technique:

By manner of watching his old idol Laxus of Fairy Tail, Hunter was able to study the Lightning Dragon Slayers Lightning body technique at a young age and master a variation of it for himself.

Thunderous Footwork:

Hunter is capable of using his Thunder Magic in ways never once thought of, and in this instance he is capable of coating his movements with the explosiveness of Thunder, allowing for an additional boost of speed in his already speedy kit.

Gwydion Technique: God Trigger Stage One:

After having had undergone vigorous amounts of ruthless training from his once mentor Cygnus Gwydion, Hunter has completed the first step of the God Trigger technique, a technique that enhances all capabilities of the user at the expense of a higher Magic drain.

God Trigger Stage Two:

With further help from Cygnus, Hunter was able to push his limits even further for an even deadlier variation of his Trigger technique. Once again, the user's body is pushed into a higher state of strain to allow for an overall higher output to their capabilities at the cost of a larger Magic drain.

God Trigger Stage 2.5:

Having had learned everything about the God Trigger from Cygnus, Hunter was instructed to go no further than Stage 2 due to the risks that Stage 3 could cause on his mortal body. Instead, Hunter would go on to perfect the Trigger in his own way by first brutally tapping into Stage 3 for an understanding of it. The process would nearly kill him, but in the end, Hunter would manage to simmer the final Stage of the God Trigger into a more streamlined version. Albeit his strength remains the same as his Stage 2 form, his speed and magical output becomes dramatically increased at nearly the same margin of magical drain.

Lightning Flicker: Expanding upon the capabilities of Laxus' Lightning Body Technique, Hunter has rooted out the downsides of the forms need for constant movement and instead created has created a way to momentarily flicker in place for up to eight seconds. While not a great form to use offensively, defensively Hunter has found his uses in it.
